an amazingly detailed and inspiring account of the only daytime air expedition to help polish freedom fighters during world war ii books monthly the frantic operations were conceived in late 1943 during world war ii making soviet airfields accessible to long range american aircraft based in italy and later england yet stalin had to be persuaded by the united states to let them use frantic to drop supplies to the poles after the warsaw uprising began in 1944 on september 18 1944 american b 17 flying fortresses supported by fighter planes dropped arms ammunition medical supplies and food over the city of warsaw the assistance came too late and had no bearing on the situation of the polish freedom fighters in warsaw but the events of that day and the courage of 1 220 airmen who risked their lives are still remembered by the poles of warsaw a thoroughly researched impressively detailed and exceptionally well written history this book gives a full narrative of the frantic 7 operation itself midwest book review using firsthand accounts of the events from the freedom fighters on the ground in warsaw the fates of the young aircrew in particular those of i ll be seeing you are told in detail it also sets frantic 7 in its political context and explains how the diplomatic wrangles helped set the stage for the breakdown in relations between the soviet union and the united states and the beginning of the path to the cold war

when the first american servicemen arrived in england in march 1942 the indigenous population greeted their presence with mixed feelings a certain level of resentment of these newcomers was harboured by the english and expressed by many in the in the well worn phase of the time over paid over sexed and over here but without the presence of american servicemen in britain and its huge military and industrial muscle the war with germany would probably have been lost using a combination of contemporary eyewitness and documentary sources plus latter day interviews linked together by engaging narrative helen milligate takes a look at the background to the friendly invasion where they all came from who they were where they were stationed and what they did she examines how the yanks got on with the locals how they fitted in or didn t their impact on the social structure of england in the 1940s the problems they brought with them and their impressions of england she concludes with the journey home once the war in europe had ended describing what the yanks left behind them and the wives and sweethearts they took stateside

a bewildering feature of so much contemporary political violence is its stunning impersonality every major city centre becomes a potential shooting gallery and every metro system a potential bomb alley victims just happen as the saying goes to be in the wrong place at the wrong time we accept this contemporary reality at least to some degree but we rarely ask where has it come from historically killing strangers tackles this question head on it examines how such violence became unchained from inter personal relationships it traces the rise of such impersonal violence by examining violence in conjunction with changing social and political realities in particular it traces both push and pull the ability of modern states to force the violence of their challengers into niche forms and the disturbing new opportunities that technological changes offer to cause mayhem in fresh and original ways killing strangers therefore aims to highlight the very strangeness of contemporary experience when it is viewed against a long term perspective atrocities regularly capture media attention and just as quickly fade from public view that is both tragic and utterly predictable deep down we expect no different and that is why such atrocities must be repeated if our attention is to be re engaged deep down we expect that too so killing strangers deliberately asks the very simplest of questions how on earth did we get here

like the long reach down to earth is a message from the battle at its height told in their own words by the men who fight this is how brig gen francis griswold viii fighter command ends his introduction to this book his official endorsement reveals just how important a document down to earth was to the teaching of tyro fighter pilots heading for action in the eto more leading aces were lost to flak whilst ground strafing than to german fighters in this book william hess has included biographies of all the pilots that originally contributed to this work back in 1943 44
