the present introduction to social psychology represents an attempt at a more synthetic type of treatment of the field than has ordinarily been given it seems to the writer that the time has arrived when schools of social psychology may properly be regarded as obsolete and the subject as a whole may be presented systematically in a sense social psychology overlaps a very large portion of social science and of psychology and education in this
