fairness and fear i was startled at the subtitle of the book when i first heard it our series has some imaginative titles but none so evocative as this one but fear and fairness capture much of teacher thinking about assessment indeed teachers struggle to be fair with students certainly concerned and often fearful of failures to be fair and repercussions that teachers can face as a result then there is the fearful enterprise of imposed assessment regimes that many teachers face dr yung s book allows us to hear from the teachers on these
