through belgium passing slightly south of brussels for the modern period this definition is clear enough but for former times it needs some explanation what do we mean for example when we use the term dutch for the medieval period in the middle ages there was no standard dutch language and when the term dutch is used in a medieval context it is a kind of collective word indicating a number of different but closely related frankish dialects the most important of those were the dialects of the duchies of limburg and brabant and of the counties of flanders and holland
