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food borne diseases are an important cause of morbidity and mortality and a significant impediment to socioeconomic development worldwide but the full extent and burden of unsafe food is unknown precise information on the burden of food borne diseases can adequately inform policy makers allowing them to allocate appropriate resources for food safety control and intervention efforts in 2007 the world health organization who listed food safety as an increasingly important public health issue hence governments all over the world are intensifying their efforts to improve food safety a study conducted by who to estimate the global burden of food borne diseases revealed that the most frequent cause of food borne illnesses were diarrheal disease agents particularly norovirus and campylobacter spp food borne diarrheal disease agents caused 230 000 deaths particularly non typhoidal salmonella

enterica that causes diarrheal and invasive diseases other major causes of food borne deaths were salmonella enterica salmonella typhi taenia solium hepatitis a virus and aflatoxin forty percent of the food borne disease burden was amongst children under five years of age who 2015 to prevent food borne illness it is necessary to understand how food becomes unsafe and what proactive measures can be taken to ensure food safety in this context fao commissioned al markaz for development and marketing consultancies al markaz to conduct this study to identify palestinian households knowledge attitudes and practices kap on food safety and kap gaps as well as to develop a proper educational program for households this report presents the main findings of the study based on a survey of a representative sample of household consumers in the west bank and gaza strip wbg
