radicalism is an inclusive political tradition that lives on in the movement for black lives m4bl key radical principles include empowering people to advocate for themselves and their communities the idea that power must embrace accountability and a transformative interpretation of justice and change everyone is not a radical any more than everyone supports the m4bl and yet some people claim to support the m4bl while rejecting radical movement principles and often practicing deeply anti radical politics in invisible weapons marcus board jr wrestles with these contradictions and reveals the key political stumbling blocks posed by government powerbrokers from elected officials to welfare bureaucrats in the face of radical political movements board shows how neoliberalism is synonymous with anti radicalism and uses invisible weapons that stop oppressed people from advocating for their own needs and grievances board argues that the insidious power of co optation is transforming participation in mass social movements potentially rendering active resistance ineffective to support his argument he looks at long term unemployed black welfare recipients in chicago original survey data and case studies of police shootings in baltimore and new york at the center of invisible weapons are the seemingly conflicting responses to the 2015 baltimore city police murder of freddie gray jr and the 2016 neglectful non response to the baltimore county police murder of korryn gaines beyond geography and personal histories board shows that gray and gaines are also deeply connected by the myriad systemic failures that shaped their lives and the aftermath of their deaths further reveals the ways that oppressed masses are being silenced by the state under a veil of anti radicalism invisible weapons teaches us how state co optation of social movements like the m4bl is stealing power from people this happens both in revolts like the baltimore uprising when people are consciously resisting and in cases memorialized by countless sayhername campaigns when the masses are conspicuously absent neoliberalism and its proponents are creating an anti democratic political landscape by convincing people falsely that radicalism has no place in u s politics but strategies of non violence equality and cooperation alone are insufficient means to regain this lost power and to stop lives from being destroyed grassroots resistance must also return to radicalism remaining inclusive while also rejecting co optation politics embracing political and community self defense and recommitting to

abolition

from sartre to levinas continental philosophers have looked to the example of the jew as the paradigmatic object of and model for ethical inquiry levinas for example powerfully dedicates his 1974 book otherwise than being to the victims of the holocaust and turns attention to the state of philosophy after auschwitz such an ethics radically challenges prior notions of autonomy and comprehension two key ideas for traditional ethical theory and more generally the greek tradition it seeks to respect the opacity of the other and avoid the dangers of hermeneutic violence but how does such an ethics of the other translate into real everyday life what is at stake in thinking the other as jew is the alterity of the jew simply a counter to greek universalism is a rhetoric of exceptionalism with its unavoidable ontological residue at odds with shifting political realities within this paradigm what then becomes of the arab or muslim the other of the jew the other of the other so to speak this line of ethical thought in its desire to bear witness to past suffering and come to terms with subjectivity after auschwitz arguably brackets from analysis present operations of power would then a more sensitive historical approach expose the palestinian as the other of the israeli here zahi zalloua offers a challenging intervention into how we configure the contemporary

decolonisation after democracy addresses the provocative idea that we need to rid higher education of lingering forms of colonial knowledge this matters because in the colonial era much knowledge was put to the service of subjugating indigenous peoples and the assumptions from this era may linger into the present examples of deep rooted and foundational forms of knowledge that carry colonial traits are normative binaries such as civilised and backward modern and traditional and rational and superstitious in addition some accounts of positive values like freedom equality justice and democracy may hide the assumption that the western experience is the norm from which other kinds are rendered imitations deviations or pathologies in this collection some of south africa s leading political scientists and academics engage with the challenge of decolonising knowledge in the research and teaching of politics it includes new insights about the state international relations clientelism statesociety relations and land reform and introduces new ways to engage the colonial library curriculum reform and the marginality of historically black institutions finally the contributors deal with the decolonial challenge posed by the feesmustfall student movements reflecting on issues of revolutionary politics and gender and sexual violence this book was originally published as a special issue of politikon
