family stories and funny stories from hunting camp graduate school ministry and his job as a high school social studies teacher in new york city in his fifteen years as an educator dozens of students encouraged mr geist to write a memoir because they found his stories interesting humorous and inspirational he was voted teacher of the year in 2012 by his peers the same year his assistant principal took him to arbitration to steal his livelihood for him speaking out against the change from teacher centered teaching to classes becoming times of group work where most of the time was not being spent on the curriculum or preparing for the new york state exams it is a memoir of his careers marriage divorce heartbreak relationships human rights activism against genocide and modern day slavery it is a story of an urban teacher in the midst of changes in the public education paradigm and a failed political candidate shot with slings and arrows of dirty tricks and false charges it has stories of arbitration and court battles and recovery from codependency through the twelve step program learning how to accept life on lifes terms you will find yourself laughing on almost every page and identifying with many of the human conundrums we face in life because life is often stranger than fiction

battles fought between mexican american and apache warriors led by nana and geronimo

before perusing this work it is as well that the reader should understand m zola s aim in writing it and his views as distinct from those of his characters upon lourdes its grotto and its cures a short time before the book appeared m zola was interviewed upon the subject by his friend and biographer mr robert h sherard to whom he spoke as follows lourdes came to be written by mere accident in 1891 i happened to be travelling for my pleasure with my wife in the basque country and by the pyrenees and being in the neighbourhood of lourdes included it in my tour i spent fifteen days there and was greatly struck by what i saw and it then occurred to me that there was material here for just the sort of novel that i like to write a novel in which great masses of men can be shown in motion un grand mouvement de foule a novel the subject of which stirred up my philosophical ideas it was too late then to study the question for i had visited lourdes late in september and so had missed seeing the best pilgrimage which takes place in august under the direction of the peres de la misericorde of the rue de l assomption in paris the national pilgrimage as it is called these fathers are very active enterprising men and have made a great success of this annual national pilgrimage under their direction thirty thousand pilgrims are transported to lourdes including over a thousand sick persons so in the following year i went in august and saw a national pilgrimage and followed it during the three days which it lasts in addition to the two days given to travelling after its departure i stayed on ten or twelve days working up the subject in every detail my book is the story of such a national pilgrimage and is accordingly the story of five days it is divided into five parts each of which parts is limited to one day

henry miller is one of the least stylistically understood modern writers having been dubbed a zen saint and ostracized as a happy pornographer miller is now relegated to the museum of literary oddities and his text treated with unjustified indifference if the influence of french surrealism has been recognized by most critics and readers it is not without a cost miller is safely classified as a surrealist writer and most if not all of his stylistic peculiarities are thus conveniently disposed of what miller s texts share with those of the french surrealists is an imagery of excess indeed but one which is economically and masterfully geared toward a reader whose response s help in constructing a peculiarly millerian version of stylistic deviation this study focuses on the way this millerian text invites a fresh re reading of one of america s leading modern authors
