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this is the second of three related empirically based studies examining the broad range of issues raised by the use of economic sanctions this volume provides a detailed examination of the impact of u s economic sanctions on china cuba and iran as well as the impact on the united states itself ashari forrer teegen and yang analyze whether or not these case studies in economic sanctions had been successful by measuring their historical impact and modeling their effectiveness this book will be of particular interest to scholars students researchers and the public policy community involved with international business and economics and international relations

this book provides a broad overview of what peace research is all about by an author who has been involved in the field for more than half a century among other things it gives a unique review of how peace research emerged in sweden as the author was a key actor in the most crucial events during this formative period the book also portrays how the discipline has grown from an initial focus on alternatives to war to the comprehensive study of the many dimensions of a lasting and positive peace the author s own work covers causes of war sanctions conflict resolution conflict data mediation and quality peace they demonstrate the range of topics that have to be understood for a peace with quality this is exemplified by some of the author s writings specifically selected for this volume plus a few ones original to it some accounts of the author s involvements in actual peace processes in the 1990s are also included this publication offers a substantial contribution to understanding the evolution of peace research as a field and is an important reading for scholars policy makers journalists students and any aspiring peace researcher as well as for the public at large peter wallensteen is a global pioneer of peace research due to his involvement in the creation of the department of peace and conflict research at uppsala university a major center in the field he served as head of department from 1972 to 1999 peter wallensteen set up and directed the well known uppsala conflict data program ucdp the global resource for the study of armed conflicts and peace negotiations 1978 2015 peter wallensteen was the first holder of the dag hammarskjöld chair in peace and conflict research at uppsala university 1985 2012 he was also the first holder of the position as the richard g starmann sr research professor of peace studies at the kroc institute for international peace studies university of notre dame usa 2006 2018

in this original study of intellectual property rights ipr in relation to state capacity dimitrov analyzes this puzzle by offering the first systematic analysis of all ipr enforcement avenues in china across all ipr subtypes he shows that the extremely high volume of enforcement provided for copyrights and trademarks is unfortunately of a low quality and as such serves only to perpetuate ipr violations in the area of patents however he finds a low volume of high quality enforcement in light of these findings the book develops a theory of state capacity that conceptualizes the chinese state as simultaneously weak and strong the book draws on extensive fieldwork in china and five other countries as well as on 10 unique ipr enforcement datasets that exploit previously unexplored sources including case files of private investigation firms

the european union has devoted growing attention to sanctions since the entry into force of the maastricht treaty in total the council has imposed common foreign and security policy cfsp sanctions targeting countries economic sectors groups individuals and entities on 27 different occasions the novelty in the area of sanctions is that targets are not only states as in the recent cases of iran and syria but they are also individuals and non state entities e g anti terrorist lists president robert mugabe and his associates and several companies connected with the military junta in burma myanmar additionally the contexts in which sanctions are utilised can be diverse ranging from the protection of human rights to crisis management and non proliferation despite the fact that the effectiveness of sanctions has been much debated the eu has

developed a sanctioning policy and intensified its adoption of sanctions sanctions were traditionally seen as a way to impose economic penalties as a means of extracting political concessions from targets but eu sanctions do not always impose a cost nor do they always seek to induce behavioural change to this extent a new narrative may be needed
