with the prominence of one name couples brangelina kimye and famous families the smiths the beckhams it is becoming increasingly clear that celebrity is no longer an individual pursuit if it ever was accordingly first comes love explores celebrity kinship and the phenomenon of the power couple those relationships where two stars come together and where their individual identities as celebrities become inseparable from their status as a famous twosome taken together the chapters in this volume interrogate the ways these alliances are bound up in wider cultural debates about marriage love intimacy family parenthood sexuality and gender in their particular historical contexts from the 1920s to the present day interdisciplinary in scope first comes love seeks to establish how celebrity relationships play particular roles in dramatizing disrupting and reconciling often contradictory ideas about coupledness and kinship formations

this bibliography extends the work of stanley s first volume the foreign critical reputation of f scott fitzgerald an analysis and annotated bibliography to the final two decades of the 20th century it includes literature from the former countries of the ussr romania india and canada as well as countries that were covered in the first volume such as britain france italy germany and japan one of the major findings that emerges is that fitzgerald s poetic prose is extremely difficult to translate but new translations continue to appear the introduction to this volume provides a synthesis of fitzgerald scholarship abroad at the turn of the 21st century and points to new directions already suggested that may represent challenges to current scholarship an extended analysis introduces each chapter each chapter also includes a chronological list of translations and editions of fitzgerald s work from his earliest appearances in print to those appearing in 2000 the most substantial section of each chapter features fairly detailed annotations of monographs collections book chapters essays conference papers articles reviews and school editions this compilation will intrigue anyone interested the work of f scott fitzgerald

f scott fitzgerald is one of the most challenging authors of american literature he is known

internationally as the author of *The Great Gatsby* 1925 a twentieth century literary classic studied by high school students and scholars alike but Fitzgerald was an amazingly productive writer despite numerous personal and professional difficulties from the beginning of his literary career with the publication of *This Side of Paradise* in 1920 to his death in 1940 he wrote 5 novels roughly 180 short stories numerous essays and reviews much poetry several plays and some film scripts even when he wrote hastily and perhaps bleary eyed his works almost always exhibit the flashes of his genius he is celebrated as a symbol of the jazz age and the roaring twenties but beneath all the glitter for which his prose is famous he warns of the dangers of personal recklessness and praises the redemptive power of love through hundreds of alphabetically arranged entries this reference book provides complete coverage of Fitzgerald's life and writings the volume begins with a chronology that traces his rise from obscurity to fame his struggles with alcoholism and his eventual financial downfall the entries that follow give a full and detailed picture of Fitzgerald and his work they present the essential action in Fitzgerald's novels short stories plays and poems identify all named fictional characters and indicate their significance and give brief biographical information for Fitzgerald's family members friends and professional associates many of the entries include bibliographies which emphasize criticism published after 1990 and the volume closes with a general bibliography of the most important broad studies of Fitzgerald and his works a thorough index and extensive cross references provide additional access to the wealth of information in this reference book and help make it a useful tool for a wide range of users

the fiction of F. they say justice is blind but justine isn't justine tina clancy is just an ordinary law student with a faulty arrest record a part time job in baltimore's radioactive zone and a family secret so bizarre even she doesn't believe it that is until in a fit of fury she damns her boyfriend to hell and it's exactly where he ends up much to her surprise tina is apparently one of saturn's daughters with the power to wield vigilante justice but poor max didn't deserve to go up in flames even if he did almost run her over with her own car tina's convinced someone cut the brakes and now a relentless nemesis is stalking her through the zone's back alleys where buildings glow statues move and chemical waste exposure comes with interesting consequences tina's usually a loner but now she needs a posse like no other a shape shifting kitten an invisible thief a biker gang a snake charming private detective a well meaning cop and her sleazy sexy boss but in between freeing max from hell saving her own neck and solving a mystery that threatens the zone and her newfound friends how is she ever going to study for finals

the romance between f scott fitzgerald and zelda sayre has been celebrated as one of the greatest of the 20th century from the beginning their relationship was a tumultuous one in which the couple's excesses were as widely known as their passion for each other despite their love both scott and zelda engaged in flirtations that threatened to tear the couple apart but none had a more profound impact on the two and on scott's writing as the liaison between zelda and a french aviator edouard jozan though other biographies have written of jozan as one of scott's romantic rivals accounts of the pilot's effect on the couple have been superficial at best in the gatsby affair scott zelda and the betrayal that shaped an american classic

kendall taylor examines the dalliance between the southern belle and the french pilot from a fresh perspective drawing on conversations and correspondence with joan's daughter as well as materials from the joan family archives taylor sheds new light on this romantic triangle more than just a casual fling zelda's tryst with edouard affected scott as much as it did his wife and ultimately influenced the author's most famous creation jay gatsby were it not for zelda's affair with the pilot scott's novel might be less about betrayal and more about lost illusions exploring the private motives of these public figures taylor offers new explanations for their behavior in addition to the love triangle that included joan taylor also delves into an earlier event in zelda's life a sexual assault she suffered as a teenager one that affected her future relationships both a literary study and a probing look at an iconic couple's psychological makeup the gatsby affair offers readers a bold interpretation of how one of america's greatest novels was influenced
