in december 2006 the united nations general assembly adopted a resolution on intensi cation of efforts to eliminate all forms of violence against women a res 61 143 this resolution followed the launch of the secretary general s in depth study on violence against women in october 2006 a 61 122 add 1 and corr 1 and is the rst ever comprehensive action by the general assembly on this persistent scourge that potentially affects one woman in three in the course of her lifetime the resolution urges member states to exercise leadership and devise systematic comprehensive multi sectoral and sustained approaches adequately supported and facilitated by strong institutional mechanisms and nancing to eliminate all forms of violence against women in particular it calls upon member states to establish national plans of action on the elimination of violence against women undertake legislative capacity building and awareness raising measures provide services for women and ensure the systematic collection and analysis of data the resolution calls upon the entities of the united nations system to support national efforts especially with respect to data collection and the development of national plans of action it urges them to enhance coordination and intensify their efforts to eliminate all forms of violence against women and girls it also notes the need to provide adequate resources to efforts throughout the united nations system to eliminate violence against women and girls
