Edward Gordon Craig (1872–1966) is particularly known among theatre practitioners and students of the theatre as a pioneer in what has been referred to as the New Movement in the theatre, commencing with his experimental productions in the early years of the twentieth century. His first book, *The Art of the Theatre*, published in 1905, although labelled an impractical dreamer by his detractors, he successfully designed and produced a baker's dozen of plays and operas, ranging from the amateur *Dido and Aeneas* in 1900 to the renowned co-production with Constantin Stanislavsky of *Hamlet* at the Moscow Art Theatre from the highly revolutionary production of Ibsen's *The Vikings* in 1903, under Ellen Terry's management, with her appearing as Hjordis to Ibsen's *The Pretenders* for the Royal Theatre in Copenhagen in the 20s.
