this first socio organizational history of the gestapo the sd and the regular detectives of the third reich 1932 1937 this book explores the roots of their roles in police terror and programs of mass murder these personnel helped to form the character and missions of their organizations which were not simply created from above by hitler himmler or heydrich hitler s enforcers is based on research at 34 archives in germany and the united states including the personnel files of over 1 000 former members and is the first such study to benefit from the german documents captured by the soviets and poles and kept secret until recently

the image of the third reich as a monolithic state presiding over the brainwashed fanatical masses retains a tenacious grip on the general public s imagination however a growing body of research on the social history of the nazi years has revealed the variety and complexity of the relationships between the nazi regime and the german people this volume makes this new research accessible to undergraduate and graduate students alike

a comprehensive study of the lesser known organizations that formed the heart of the nazi police state in world war ii germany the abbreviation nazi the acronym gestapo and the initials ss have become resonant elements of our vocabulary less known is sd and hardly anyone recognizes the combination sipo and sd although sipo and sd formed the heart of the national socialist police state the phrase carries none of the ominous impact that it should although no single organization carries full responsibility for the evils of the third reich the ss police system was the executor of terrorism and population policy in the same way the military carried out the reich s imperialistic aggression within the police state even the concentration camps could not rival the impact of sipo and sd it was the source not only of the desk murderers who administered terror and genocide by assigning victims to the camps but also of the police executives for identification and arrest and of the command and staff for a major instrument of execution the einsatzgruppen foundations of the nazi police state offers the narrative and analysis of the external struggle that created sipo and sd this book is the author s preface to his discussion of the internal evolution of these organizations in hitler s enforcers the gestapo and the ss security service in the nazi revolution a welcome addition to the literature on national socialist germany american historical review sheds new light on himmler s role

a poor village boy from the bremerhaven area joins the army and gets transferred into the new luftwaffe he becomes a fighter ace in spain with the condor legion and is awarded an iron cross and meets the fuhrer he is then transferred to work for a field marshall and meets his love for life on a visit to a death camp in poland he saves her life and they marry in bremerhaven via a friendly priest he designs an escape plan in early part of war for senior nazis and military to escape to argentina if the war was ever lost which was impossible for it to be however it is lost by the fuhrer s decisons and they escape to argentina and make new lives there his jewish wife and him raise a family and start businesses and live happily until a happy event goes badly wrong and they both die but their love survives nazi hatred and they meet once again out there in the cosmos to be together for eternity

and again i want to state that i have lived one of the most bizarre wildest dangerous and tragic life any human being could have ever lived i have been stabbed and shot before damn near beaten to death by people with baseball bats and being catholic received my last rites two times in my life i made a lot of big money blew a lot of big money did a lot of gambling drank a lot of alcohol did a lot of drugs and from becoming a normal sex addict i became a hardcore sadist and masochist sex addict

usually given short shrift in most histories of world war ii hitler s invasion of poland was more than a series of opening salvos it was a testing ground for german brutalities to come this is a comprehensive study of the campaign including insights into its ideological underpinnings

they were foot soldiers and officers they served in the regular army and the waffen ss and remarkably they were also jewish at least as defined by hitler s infamous race laws pursuing the thread he first unraveled in hitler s jewish soldiers bryan rigg takes a closer look at the experiences of wehrmacht soldiers who were classified as jewish in this long awaited companion volume he presents interviews with twenty one of these men whose stories are both fascinating and disturbing

as many as 150 000 jews and partial jews or mischlinge served often with distinction in the german military during world war ii the men interviewed for this volume portray a wide range of experiences some came from military families some had been raised christian revealing in vivid detail how they fought for a government that robbed them of their rights and sent their relatives to extermination camps yet most continued to serve since resistance would have cost them their lives and they mistakenly hoped that by their service they could protect themselves and their families the interviews recount the nature and extent of their dilemma the divided loyalties under which many toiled during the nazi years and afterward and their sobering reflections on religion and the holocaust including what they knew about it at the time rigg relates each individual s experiences following the establishment of hitler s race laws shifting between vivid scenes of combat and the increasingly threatening situation on the home front for these men and their family members their stories reveal the constant tension in their lives how some tried to hide their identities and how a few were even aryanized as part of hitler s effort to retain reliable soldiers including field marshal erhard milch three star general helmut wilberg and naval commander bernhard rogge chilling compelling almost beyond belief these stories depict crises of conscience under the most stressful circumstances lives of hitler s jewish soldiers deepens our understanding of the complex intersection of nazi race laws and german military service both before and during world war ii

when the german wehrmacht swarmed across eastern europe an elite corps followed close at its heels along with the ss and gestapo the ordnungspolizei or uniformed police played a central role in nazi genocide that until now has been generally neglected by historians of the war beginning with the invasion of poland the uniformed police were charged with following the army to curb resistance pacify the countryside patrol jewish ghettos and generally maintain order in the conquered territories edward westermann examines how this force emerged as a primary instrument of annihilation responsible for the murder of hundreds of thousands of the third reich s political and racial enemies in hitler s police battalions he reveals how the institutional mindset of these ordinary policemen allowed them to commit atrocities without a second thought to uncover the story of how the german national police were fashioned into a corps of political soldiers westermann reveals initiatives pursued before the war by heinrich himmler and kurt dalwege to create a culture within the existing police forces that fostered anti semitism and anti communism as institutional norms challenging prevailing interpretations of german culture westermann draws on extensive archival research including the testimony of former policemen to illuminate this transformation and the callous organizational culture that emerged purged of dissidents indoctrinated to idolize hitler and trained in military combat these police battalions often numbering several hundred men repeatedly conducted actions against jews slavs gypsies asocials and other groups on their own initiative even when they had the choice not to in addition to documenting these atrocities westermann examines cooperation between the ordnungspolizei and the ss and gestapo and the close relationship between police and wehrmacht in the conduct of the anti partisan campaign of annihilation throughout westermann stresses the importance of ideological indoctrination and organizational initiatives within specific groups it was the organizational culture of the uniformed police he maintains and not german culture in general that led these men to commit genocide hitler s police battalions provides the most complete and comprehensive study to date of this neglected branch of himmler s ss and police empire and adds a new dimension to our understanding of the holocaust and the war on the eastern front

on the murderous road to racial purity hitler encountered unexpected detours largely due to his own crazed views and inconsistent policies regarding jewish identity after centuries of jewish assimilation and intermarriage in german society he discovered that eliminating jews from the rest of the population was more difficult than he d anticipated as bryan rigg shows in this provocative new study nowhere was that heinous process more fraught with contradiction and confusion than in the german military contrary to conventional views rigg reveals that a startlingly large number of german military men were classified by the nazis as jews or partial jews mischlinge in the wake of

racial laws first enacted in the mid 1930s rigg demonstrates that the actual number was much higher than previously thought perhaps as many as 150 000 men including decorated veterans and high ranking officers even generals and admirals as rigg fully documents for the first time a great many of these men did not even consider themselves jewish and had embraced the military as a way of life and as devoted patriots eager to serve a revived german nation in turn they had been embraced by the wehrmacht which prior to hitler had given little thought to the race of these men but which was now forced to look deeply into the ancestry of its soldiers the process of investigation and removal however was marred by a highly inconsistent application of nazi law numerous exemptions were made in order to allow a soldier to stay within the ranks or to spare a soldier s parent spouse or other relative from incarceration or far worse hitler s own signature can be found on many of these exemption orders but as the war dragged on nazi politics came to trump military logic even in the face of the wehrmacht s growing manpower needs closing legal loopholes and making it virtually impossible for these soldiers to escape the fate of millions of other victims of the third reich based on a deep and wide ranging research in archival and secondary sources as well as extensive interviews with more than four hundred mischlinge and their relatives rigg s study breaks truly new ground in a crowded field and shows from yet another angle the extremely flawed dishonest demeaning and tragic essence of hitler s rule
