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the age of information has spawned a critical focus on human communication in a multimedia world particularly on theories and practices of writing with the worldwide web impacting increasingly on academic and business communication the need has never been greater for advanced study in writing communication and critical thinking across all genres sectors and cultures in recent decades the definitions of new rhetoric have expanded to encompass a variety of theories and movements raising the question of how rhetoric is understood and employed in the twenty first century the essays collected here represent variations on these themes with each attempting to answer the title s deliberately provocative question addressing particularly how the classical art of rhetoric is still relevant today

how it is directly related to modern technologies and the new modes of communication they have generated how rhetorical practice is informing research methodologies and teaching and learning practices in the contemporary academy

where the new world is assesses how fiction published since 1980 has resituated the u s south globally and how earlier twentieth century writing already had done so in ways traditional southern literary studies tended to ignore martyn bone argues that this body of fiction has over the course of some eighty years challenged received readings and understandings of the u s south as a fixed place largely untouched by immigration or even internal migration and economic globalization the writers discussed by bone emphasize how migration and labor have reconfigured the region s relation to the nation and a range of transnational scales hemispheric jamaica the bahamas haiti transatlantic black atlantic denmark england mauritania and transpacific global southern australia china vietnam writers under consideration include zora neale hurston nella larsen john oliver killens russell banks erna brodber cynthia shearer ha jin monique truong lan cao toni morrison peter matthiessen dave eggers and laila lalami the book also seeks to resituate southern studies by drawing on theories of scale that originated in human geography in this way bone also offers a new paradigm in which the u s south is thoroughly engaged with a range of other scales from the local to the global making both literature about the region and southern studies itself truly transnational in scope

focus mainly on the latter but i also explain an unexpected but critically important connection between them dependent on the teaching nearly all christian denominations either teach nothing at all on it or almost the opposite of what scripture repeatedly showed me looking back i find this absolutely staggering very few christians understand that the new covenant also only applies to israel as i will clearly show i no longer believe that the nt new testament can be fully understood without this extra israel dimension had i felt i could deliver this in a more light hearted way i would have done so but its implications are too awesome and fundamental to our eternal life prospects for that

the economic and social problems of modern scotland are at the centre of current debate about regional economic growth social improvement and environmental rehabilitation in this book as relevant today as when it was first published in 1975 anthony slaven argues that the extent and causes of these problems are frequently underestimated thus making development policies less than fully effective the major economic and social weaknesses of the west of scotland are shown to be rooted in the regions former strengths the author demonstrates how although the region and its people have resisted change a thriving and self reliant nineteenth century economy based on local resources and manpower has given way in the present century to vanishing skills and products unemployment and social deprivation since 1945 economic and social planning has helped to improve the situation although many difficulties remain seen in the historical perspective provided by this revealing study the present industrial problems of the west of scotland and their remedies become clearer mr slaven argues that the older industries deserve more help for without this he believes the ineffectiveness of development policies is likely to be perpetuated this book was first published in 1975
