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originally published in 1994 the story of hansel and gretel is familiar to many people most believe that the witch was wicked but has this issue ever been seriously challenged in the introduction to this book marvin wideen describes the day he saw this well known fairy story being taught and through it draws us along a path of education reform in lakeview school british columbia and shows how by this process of reform the school changed from within he considers the ideology supporting educational change what change means to those who undertake it and how the experience relates to the larger social and political context the book effectively demonstrates that change will always create anxiety needs careful and sensitive implementation and occurs in isolation or as a result of activity within a larger context

this book seeks to explore how disability is understood and the position and experiences of disabled people both within and across different societies the authors explore the question of politics in relation to specific struggles providing a wealth of insights and ideas and examine the nature and value of a social model of disability they criticize exclusionary barriers while advancing a more democratic and participatory society based on principles of equality offer cross cultural insights and present stimuli for debate and further research the text is accessible topical and provides new and innovatory thinking this book will appeal to undergraduate and postgraduate students lecturers and researchers with interests in education social policy sociology and disability studies

women violence and social change demonstrates how refuges and shelters stand as the core of the battered women s movement providing a basis for pragmatic support political action and radical renewal from this base movements in britain and the united states have challenged the police courts and social services to provide greater assistance to women the book provides important evidence on the way social movements can successfully challenge institutions of the state as well as salutatory lessons on the nature of diverted and thwarted struggle throughout the book the dobashes years of researching violence against women is illustrated in the depth of their analysis they maintain the tradition established in their first book violence against wives which was widely accalimed

this book is a study of radicals revolutionaries and society specifically it tries to look at the historical social and political struggles of radicals in modern politics since the emergence of modern politics after the french revolution of 1789 while the book is a political study the main focus is that of a socialist study as a socialist argument for the vital political role of radicals and revolutionaries in creating modern society the main focus of the book is on how radicals and revolutionaries usually change modern society for the better through their struggle for democracy freedom and socialism

this work by karl julius reubke embodies labours of experience and reflection spanning almost 20 years it is rich with many kinds of detail but above all reubke s work accomplishes something the late german philosopher hans georg gadamer called a horizontverschmelzung a merging of horizons in service of an act of understanding reubke a german himself a former chemist a follower of rudolph steiner a self taught sanskrit scholar and translator of ancient texts sympathetically merges those horizons with an equally complex set of horizons arising from india the post colonial search for a coherent tradition in one of the oldest civilizations the emergence of early modern spiritual and nationalist thinking the complex challenges posed by gandhi s ethico spiritual vision and then finally from the contemporary india driven and riven by the forces of globalization the horizon of a civil social movement inspired by gandhi and vinobha namely ekta parishad reubke describes this movement inspired and led by pv rajagopal from the inside with a personal touch and a uncannily reflective eye all of this is an accomplishment of some note and worthy of our attention especially as we now turn to confront how we as people of the planet will face the ecological disaster our way of living has created this too is a task of comprehension which hannah arendt described as the work of the unpremeditated facing up to and resisting of reality whatever it may be paul schwartzentruber independent scholar and activist halifax canada if you wish to know what satyagraha is all about read this candid reflective account of the struggle for freedom and justice gandhi and his contemporaries waged during the twentieth century and p v rajagopal and ekta parishad have been engaged in during the 21st extremely timely and morally challenging manoranjan mohanty former professor of political science university of delhi new delhi india this book is invaluable in challenging us to develop nonviolent mass

a fairer system at the local national and global levels

this is the second book published by vita books on makhan singh 1913 1973 the first one was makhan singh a revolutionary trade unionist published in 2015 that a second book is considered necessary is an indication that the full history and contribution of makhan singh to the working class struggles in india and kenya still need more publications to be written and placed in the public domain of course the makhan singh archives at the university of nairobi and *unquiet the life and times of makhan singh* by zarina patel remain key resources on him as kwamchetsi makokha says in the introduction of this book fewer tasks can be as challenging as constructing the larger than life profile of makhan singh a man who saw through and instantly rejected the tokenistic colonial assignment of indians to a class above africans deconstructed the hierarchical colour bar by organising trade union activities that brought the two communities together and brought a penetrating ideological clarity to the fight for self determination by making a demand for kenya's independence in 1950 while the name of makhan singh may well be more known in kenya today than in the years after his death little or not attempts have been made by trade unionists or politicians to understand and follow his ideological stand and to resist capitalism and imperialism as he did it is for this reason that the experience and the record of makhan singh needs urgent attention in kenya indeed in africa today kwamchetsi makokha concludes although it is regrettable that for over 50 years after makhan singh's death knowledge of his full contribution to the making of modern kenya has been officially suppressed and access to it denied to a significant proportion of the population the publication of the struggle has started secures this hero's place in collective memory shiraz durrani the editor of the book points to the central issue that makhan singh fought against makhan singh saw class divisions and class struggles as the primary aspects of resistance to colonialism and to ensuring that the interests of workers peasants and people of kenya were in the forefront of an independent country this was a turning point in the struggle for liberation in kenya colonialism had succeeded in previous periods to divide people's struggles along tribal or racial or regional levels thereby dividing forces of resistance makhan singh was able to see through such divisive tactics he saw the struggle as a class struggle and emphasised the need to politicise the working class unite them with other progressive classes and wage a struggle that would remove the causes of poverty and injustice from the country that struggle has not been won that is why makhan singh's teaching and experience is relevant today the book carries a reproduction of the excellent exhibition on makhan singh by khalsa lakhvir singh which was first exhibited at the macmillan library in

early 2024 they provide an overall context of the life and time of makhan singh
