this book examines the complex relationship between politics and hate speech laws domestic and international how do political contexts shape understandings of what hate speech is and how to deal with it why do particular states enact hate speech laws and then apply extend or reform them in the ways they do what part does hate speech play in international affairs why do some but not all states negotiate agree and ratify international hate speech frameworks or instruments what are some of the best and worst political arguments for and against hate speech laws do political figures have special moral duties to refrain from hate speech should the use of hate speech by political figures be protected by parliamentary privilege should this sort of hyperpolitical hate speech be subject to the laws of the land civil and criminal or should it instead be handled by parliamentary codes of conduct and procedures or even by political parties themselves what should the codes of conduct look like brown and sinclair answer these important and overlooked questions on the politics of hate speech laws providing a substantial body of new evidence insights arguments theories and practical recommendations the primary focus is on the uk and the us but several other country contexts are also explored and compared in detail including nigeria kenya south africa india china japan turkey

germany hungary and italy methodologically the two authors draw on approaches and concepts from a range of academic disciplines including law and legal theory political theory applied ethics political science and sociology international relations theory and international law

references to hate have become ubiquitous in the modern response to group defamation and violence in liberal democracies whether expressed in speech acted out in criminal conduct or seen as the fuel of terror and extremism hate is persistently considered a vice an evil and a threat to the modern liberal democracy but what exactly is at stake when societies oppose hate in hate politics law critical perspectives on combating hate thomas brudholm and birgitte schepelern johansen have gathered a group of distinguished scholars who offer a critical exploration and assessment of the basic assumptions ideals and agendas behind the modern fight against hate they explore these issues and provide a range of explanatory and normative perspectives on the awkward relationship between hate and liberal democracy as expressed for example through anti hate speech and anti hate crime initiatives the volume further examines the presuppositions and ideological roots of fighting hate as well as its blind spots and limits it also includes discussions on the definition and meaning of hate the longer and broader history of the concept of hate and when and why fighting hatred became politically salient while most research on hate crime is written and published in order to prevent and combat hate hate politics law takes a much needed theoretical historical and exploratory approach to hatred

in 1998 the horrific murders of matthew shepard a gay man living in laramie wyoming and james byrd jr an african american man dragged to his death in jasper texas provoked a passionate public outrage the intense media coverage of the murders made moments of violence based in racism and homophobia highly visible and which eventually led to the passage of the matthew shepard and james byrd jr hate crimes prevention act in 2009 the role the media played in cultivating shaping and directing the collective emotional response toward these crimes is the subject of this gripping new book by jennifer petersen tracing the emotional exchange from news stories to the creation of law petersen calls for an approach to media and democratic politics that takes into account the role of affect in the political and legal life of the nation

popular culture social media and the politics of identity advances a novel methodological approach pop culture as political object to capture the centrality of popular culture as an object of a broad range of political contests and debates that constitute pop culture artefacts by generating and informing specific meanings and understandings of them it is no longer novel to claim that popular culture matters to world politics the literature on popular culture and world politics pcwp has demonstrated the cultural basis of political action and meaning making however this book argues that in doing so the pcwp literature has focused primarily on the traditionally narrow range of issues actors and things that mainstream international relations regards as part of world politics while pcwp challenges restrictive disciplinary understandings of the sites of legitimate inquiry where one can purposefully gain knowledge about world politics comparatively little has been done to challenge constricted understandings of what world politics is who it involves and where it takes

place methodological approaches in the literature largely treat popular culture and politics as separate and therefore focus on understanding how popular culture relates to and intersects with a relatively circumscribed notion of world politics focusing on the everyday politics of how audiences perceive and contest popular cultural artefacts this book demonstrates that pop culture does not merely intersect with or reflect discrete political processes it is also directly situated as an object of politics the author analyses current debates over identity politics across a range of contemporary pop cultural artefacts including films and video games this book will be of interest to scholars and students of international relations political science and cultural and media studies

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
