incapable of love yet he was unable to awaken love in others and so was soul starved but sometimes he was conscious of a great yearning and when the yearning came he was impatient and took a drink or cursed his servant or both sometimes when he was most impatient with the world and with himself he went on a spree the war began his natural impatience found something congenial in the hurry and noise of the expedition he was glad to go he had known a german in london and had disliked him thoroughly the german talked too much and his loud tones jarred on the sensitive ears of the refined officer as he led his men into
