gerald o collins sj is professor emeritus of the gregorian university rome and now adjunct professor at australian catholic university an international authority in the area of resurrection studies he has published seven books and dozens of articles on the resurrection of jesus

what will our resurrected bodies look like will we be young or old marked by the physical imperfections of our earthly lives does this flesh we carry now rise or is it something other what does our modern knowledge of the world contribute to our understanding brian schmisek traces developments in the christian understanding of resurrection explores the topic in light of biblical data and mines scientific insights what results is a

the bible gives instances of two men being translated to heaven without dying at all of some dead people who were raised to life only to die again but we never read of a resurrected man ascending to heaven save in the one exception of our lord he died and was raised the third day and having abundantly proved his resurrection to his doubting disciples he ascended to glory and set himself down at the right hand of god such a claim is stupendous prove it and you prove christianity disprove it and you disprove christianity the truth of christianity hinges on the fact of the resurrection of our lord apart from the resurrection of christ there can be no salvation no forgiveness of sins no justification and no gift of eternal life in short no christianity remove the central stone of an arch and the whole structure falls to the ground so it is with the deity and manhood of our lord jesus christ his spotless life his atoning death his resurrection and his ascension these are all linked up together making one complete whole if one part fails the whole of christianity fails so wrote algernon pollock that indefatigable apologist from the pulpit and in print wherever he saw the christian faith under attack beginning with an overview of the bible s detailing of the facts and consequences of christ s resurrection the author briefly considers old testament prophecies of the resurrection before reviewing christ s own prophecies of his death he continues with an examination of the person life and death of the lord jesus christ and their connection with his resurrection he then considers the circumstances of

the lord's resurrection before an extensive discussion of all the recorded appearances of the risen christ an examination of objections to the inspiration of the gospel accounts is followed by a look at some theories presented in denial of the resurrection significant reference is made to an interesting mid 18th century study entitled observations on the conversion and apostleship of st paul in a letter to gilbert west esq by sir george lyttleton later lord lyttleton baron of frankley lyttleton and west set out to disprove christianity by proving two key points of christianity false lyttleton that st paul did not convert to christianity and west that jesus never rose from the dead however as their researches progressed they both became convinced of the truth of the events they sought to disprove the author himself convinced of the fact of the resurrection of the lord jesus christ plainly sets out his reasons in this book

in debates over the resurrection of the dead outi lehtipuu highlights the striking observation that in many early texts the way that belief in resurrection is formulated is used as a sign of inclusion and exclusion not only in relation to non christians but vis à vis other christians those who teach otherwise have deviated from the truth are not true christians and do the works of the devil using insights from the sociological study of deviance dr lehtipuu demonstrates that labelling was used as a tool for marking boundaries between those who belonged and those who did not this was extremely important in the fluid conditions where the small christian minority groups found themselves in a situation where there were no universally accepted structures that defined what constituted the true christian belief several competing interpretations and their representatives struggled for recognition of their views based on what they believed to be the apostolic tradition the most hotly debated aspect of resurrection was whether it would entail the body of flesh and blood or not when resurrection would take place was closely related to this controversies died since the scriptural legacy was ambiguous enough to allow different hermeneutical solutions the battle over resurrection was closely related to the

question of how scriptures were to be understood as well as to what constituted the human self that would survive death to demonstrate this a wide variety of texts are studied from theological treatises including relevant nag hammadi texts to apocryphal acts and martyrologies acknowledging the complexity and diversity of the early christian movement this volume views early christian discourse as part of the broader ancient discursive world where similar debates were going on among both jews and the majority population

argues that 1 john was written to affirm jesus resurrection in light of jewish denials that he was the christ
