the plot revolves around the sexual assault of a teenage girl and an unrelated murder trial in the town of eldritch exploring a community s reaction to rape lies and murder

mr wilson handles the collage technique so beautifully that we leave convinced no other method would have served half so well this reviewer liked rimers for its fluidity for its language for its almost musical sense of pattern the new york times the mystery is who he is who murdered him and what were the circumstances and to solve it wilson looks at the outsides and insides of his tiny middle western town he looks at a middle aging woman who falls in love with the young man who comes to work in her café he looks at a coarse nasty woman mistreating her senile mother who is obsessed with visions of eldritch being evil and headed for blood spilling he looks at a tender relationship between a young man a dreamy crippled girl but wilson sees far more than this he is grasping the very fabric of bible belt america with its catchword morality virgin god fearing and its capability for the vicious he senses the rhythm of its life and the cruelty it can impose he understands the speech patterns of its loveless gossips its sex hungry boys its compassionless preachers its car conscious blondes in the end his portrait of eldritch is full length and the truth of its revelations will be pondered long after the stage lights have dimmed and the play has ended

above all wilson wants to tell the truth for him reality is almost but not quite enough by creating his drama out of his own rich life experiences he finds little need to exaggerate eugene ionesco once observed that one discovers more than one invents and that invention is really discovery or rediscovery

biographical bibliographical and critical information on more than four hundred authors who have figured prominently in gay and lesbian literature and culture since 1900

albee and influence is the fourth volume in the series new directions in edward albee studies sponsored by the edward albee society the volume contains essays written by leading albee scholars that focus on literary and philosophical influences on edward albee s plays as well as essays on writers and works that albee influenced essays focus on albee s relationship with such major american playwrights as thornton wilder amiri baraka sam shepard lanford wilson and john guare there are also contributions on albee s work as mentor to young playwrights the volume also includes an interview with award winning director pam mckinnon

in richard barr the playwright s producer author david a crespy investigates the career of one of the theatre s most vivid luminaries from his work on the film and radio productions of orson welles to his triumphant and final production of stephen sondheim s sweeney todd the demon barber of fleet street explored in detail along the way are the producer s relationship with playwright edward albee whose major plays such as a zoo story and who s afraid of virginia woolf barr was the first to produce and his innovative productions of controversial works by playwrights like samuel beckett terrence mcnally and sam shepard crespy draws on barr s own writings on the theatre his personal papers and more than sixty interviews with theatre professionals to offer insight into a man whose legacy to producers and playwrights resounds in the theatre world also included in the volume are a foreword and an afterword by edward albee a three time pulitzer prize winning playwright and one of barr s closest associates

rue mcclanahan best known for her portrayal of blanche devereaux on the emmy award winning series the golden girls reveals her life in and out of the spotlight in a laugh out loud

funny memoir about love marriage men and getting older that is every bit as colorful as the characters she played raised in small town oklahoma in a house thirteen telephone poles past the standpipe north of town rue developed her two great passions theater and men at an early age she arrived in new york city in 1957 with two weeks worth of money in her pocket hustled her way into a class with the legendary uta hagen and began working her way up in the acting world against the vibrant free spirited backdrop of the sixties that s when she met and married husband 1 a handsome rogue of an aspiring actor who quickly left her with a young son still she was determined to make it on the stage and screen and in the years that followed rose to the top of the entertainment world with a host of adventures and husbands along the way from her roles on broadway opposite dustin hoffman and brad davis to her first television appearances on maude and all in the family to the golden girls era and beyond my first five husbands is the irresistible story of one woman s quest to find herself rue is proof that many things can and do get better with age and that if she keeps her wits about her even a small town girl can make it big people always ask me if i m like blanche and i say well blanche was an oversexed self involved man crazy vain southern belle from atlanta and i m not from atlanta rue mcclanahan

before lanford wilson became a pulitzer prize winning playwright with such celebrated productions as the hot l baltimore fifth of july talley s folly and burn this he wrote dozens of short stories and poems many of which take place in the 1950s small town missouri where he grew up this selection of wilson s early work written between 1955 and 1967 when he was between the ages of 18 and 30 provides a rare look at a young writer developing his style the stories explore many of the themes wilson later took up in the theater such as sexual identity and the rupture of societies and families these never before published works part of the manuscript collection donated by wilson to the university of missouri shed light on the roots of some of america s best loved plays and are accomplished and evocative works in their own right

in this book professor berkowitz studies the diversity of american drama from the stylistic experimental plays of o neill through verse tragedy and community theatre to the theatre of the 1990s the discussions range through dramatists plays genres and themes with full supporting appendix material it also examines major dramatists such as eugene o neill arthur miller sam shephard tennessee williams and august wilson and covers not only the broadway scene but also off broadway movements and fringe theatres and such subjects as women s and african american drama
