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all the evidence for daily sabbath and festival prayers in the qumran scrolls is analysed in detail document by document on the basis of formal features and social liturgical setting these prayers are compared with each other to uncover divergent prayer traditions comparative material beyond the scrolls is used to reassess their place in the development of jewish prayer evidence for prayers of different origin found at qumran is important for reconsidering the nature of the scrolls the community s which used them and the history of jewish liturgy for several texts significant new reconstructions are offered

the author discusses the profile and development of the festivals in ancient israel in the light of the evidence from the hebrew bible old testament particular attention is paid to the sukkot festival which seems to have been a predominant festival in exilic and post exilic times this book contains two parts the first part is a study of the festival calendar in leviticus 23 the second deals with texts related to the sukkot festival the festival of booths in the hebrew bible thus focusing on the last festival of the year mentioned in leviticus 23 the second part of the book is closely connected to the first contents include introduction a sabbath of complete rest lev 23 3 passover and the massot festival lev 23 5 8 the grain festival lev 23 10 22 the trumpet blasts lev 23 24 25 the day of atonement lev 23 27 32 the sukkot festival lev 23 34 36 additions to the sukkot legislation lev 23 39 43 the dedication of the first temple and the festival in the seventh month 1 kings 8 the psalms and the sukkot festival zech 14 16 21 and the sukkot festival

the book focusses on the origin and transformation of the priestly festival calendar since the epoch making work of julius wellhausen at the end of the 19th century the differences between the various ancient israelite festival calendars have often been explained in terms of a gradual evolution which shows an increasing historicisation denaturalisation and ritualisation the festivals were in wellhausen s view gradually detached from agricultural conditions and celebrated more and more at fixed points in the year this study tries to show that

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the changes in the priestly festival calendar reflect a conscious effort to adapt the ancient israelite festival calendar to the semi annual layout of the babylonian festival year the ramifications of the change only come to the fore after a careful study of the agricultural conditions of ancient israel and mesopotamia makes clear that passover and the festival of unleavened bread were originally celebrated in the second month of the year the first month of the year envisaged by the priestly festival calendar for the celebration of passover and the festival of unleavened bread in turn mirrors the date of one of the two semi annual babylonian new year festivals the two babylonian new year festivals were celebrated exactly six months apart at the vernal and autumnal equinoxes in order to adapt the ancient israelite festival calendar to the babylonian scheme with two new year festivals a year the date of passover and the festival of unleavened bread had to be moved up by one month the consequences for the origin of passover the festival of unleavened bread the festival of weeks and the festival of huts are charted and the relations between the various ancient israelite festival calendars are determined anew

four views of the sabbath commandment seventh day fulfillment christian sabbath and lutheran are presented by scholars in point counterpoint style to determine which is most faithful to scripture

sabbath worship as a communal event does not feature in the hebrew bible in the context of the first century ce according to philo and josephus the sabbath gatherings took place only for the purpose of studying the law and not for the liturgical recital of psalms or prayer classical authors depict jews spending the sabbath at home jewish inscriptions provide no evidence of sabbath worship in prayer houses proseuchai while the mishnah prescribes no special communal sabbath activities the usual picture of jews going on the sabbath to the synagogue to worship thus appears to be without foundation it is even doubtful that there were synagogue buildings for synagogue normally meant community the conclusion of this study that there is no evidence that the sabbath was a day of communal jewish worship before 200 ce has far reaching consequences for our understanding of early jewish christian relationships this publication has also been published in hardback please click here for details

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
