effects of oxford's educational practices and the volume concludes with some reflections on the directions which the university had taken over the previous fifty years. No private institutions have exerted so profound an influence on national life over the centuries as the universities of oxford and cambridge. Few universities in the world have matched their intellectual distinction and none has evolved and maintained over so long a period a strictly comparable collegiate structure. After 1845 the imperial university saw the emergence over the following century of a new oxford a university which was still elitist but now non confessional became open to women as well as men took students from all round the empire and was held together at least until 1914 by a novel concept of christian service.
