the social origins of the welfare state traces the evolution of the first universal laws for québec families passed during the second world war in this translation of her award winning aux origines sociales de l'État providence dominique marshall examines the connections between political initiatives and québécois families in particular the way family allowances and compulsory schooling primarily benefited teenage boys who worked on family farms and girls who stayed home to help with domestic labour she demonstrates that while the promises of a minimum of welfare and education for all were by no means completely fulfilled the laws helped to uncover the existence of deep family poverty further by exposing the problem of unequal access of children of different classes to schooling these programs paved the way for education and funding reforms of the next generation another consequence was that in their equal

treatment of both genders the laws fostered the more egalitarian language of the war which faded from other sectors of society possibly laying groundwork for feminist claims of future decades the way in which the poorest families influenced the creation of public educational and welfare institutions is a dimension of the welfare state unexamined until this book at a time when the very idea of a universal welfare state is questioned the social origins of the welfare state considers the fundamental reasons behind its creation and brings to light new perspectives on its future

a discussion of the development of secret societies within china and among chinese communities in colonial southeast asia in the late 18th and 19th centuries

this is the first textbook on the history of modern ireland to adopt a social history perspective written by an international team of leading scholars it draws on a wide range of disciplinary approaches and consistently sets irish developments in a wider european and global context

this innovative text provides a compelling narrative world history through the lens of food and farmers tracing the history of agriculture from earliest times to the present christopher isett and stephen miller argue that people rather than markets have been the primary agents of agricultural change exploring the actions taken by individuals and groups over time and analyzing their activities in the wider contexts of markets states wars the environment population increase and similar factors the authors emphasize how larger social and political forces inform decisions and lead to different technological outcomes both farmers and elites responded in ways that impeded economic development farmers when able to trade with towns used the revenue to gain more land and security elites used commercial opportunities to accumulate military power and slaves the book explores these tendencies through rich case studies of ancient china precolonial south america early modern france england and japan new world slavery colonial taiwan socialist cuba and many other periods and places readers will understand how the promises and problems of contemporary agriculture are not simply technologically derived but are the outcomes of decisions and choices people have made and continue to make

this second volume continues the story told in the first by focusing on the writings of a selection of seminal thinkers in the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries in england the german speaking world and in france ending with the debate around the french revolution of 1789 tony burns discusses the work of thomas hobbes john selden sir matthew hale john locke samuel clarke johannes althusius samuel pufendorf gottfried wilhelm leibniz jean barbeyrac the anonymous author of *militaire philosophe* claud buffier l'abbé de saint pierre jean jacques burlamaqui montesquieu jean jacques rousseau l'abbé de sieyès jeremy bentham immanuel kant mary wollstonecraft and claud henri de saint simon the author concludes with an analysis of the concept of administration in the writings of saint simon as a point of transition to the discussion of the themes of bureaucracy technocracy and managerialism in the third volume

this book offers a comprehensive introduction to the social history of anthropology in the united states examining the circumstances that gave rise to the discipline and illuminating the role of anthropology in the modern world thomas c patterson considers the shifting social and political economic conditions in which anthropological knowledge has been produced and deployed

the appearance of practices focused on particular regions or groups the place of anthropology in structures of power and the role of the educator in forging perpetuating and changing representations of past and contemporary peoples the book addresses the negative reputation that anthropology took on as an offspring of imperialism and provides fascinating insight into the social history of america in this second edition the material has been revised and updated including a new chapter that covers anthropological theory and practice during the turmoil created by multiple ongoing crises at the beginning of the twenty first century this is valuable reading for students and scholars interested in the origins development and theory of anthropology

in recent years the study of nursing history in britain has been transformed by the application of concepts and methods from the social sciences to original sources the myths and legends which have grown up through a century of anecdotal writing have been chipped away to reveal the complex story of an occupation shaped and reshaped by social and technological change most of the work has been scattered in monographs journals and edited collections the skills of a social historian a sociologist and a graduate nurse have been brought together to rethink the history of modern nursing in the light of the latest scholarship the account starts by looking at the type of nursing care available in 1800 this was usually provided by the sick person s family or household servants it traces the interdependent growth of general nursing and the modern hospital and examines the separate origins and eventual integration of mental nursing district nursing health visiting and midwifery it concludes with reflections on the prospects for nursing in the year 2000

during the last few decades historians of science have shown a growing interest in science as a cultural activity and have regarded science more and more as part of the general developments that have occurred in society this trend has been less evident among historians of mathematics who traditionally concentrate primarily on tracing the development of mathematical knowledge itself to some degree this restriction is connected with the special role of mathematics compared with the other sciences mathematics typifies the most objective most coercive type of knowledge and therefore seems to be least affected by social influences nevertheless biography institutional history and history of national developments have long been elements in the historiography of mathematics this interest in the social aspects of mathematics has widened recently through the study of other themes such as the relation of mathematics to the development of the educational system some scholars have begun to apply the methods of historical sociology of knowledge to mathematics others have attempted to give a marxist analysis of the connection between mathematics and productive forces and there have been philosophical studies about the communication processes involved in the production of mathematical knowledge an interest in causal analyses of historical processes has led to the study of other factors influencing the development of mathematics such as the formation of mathematical schools the changes in the professional situation of the mathematician and the general cultural milieu of the mathematical scientist
