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to what extent should spiritual information be part of a patient s medical assessment how should physicians respond when patients refuse life saving care on religious grounds should doctors pray with their patients questions such as these raise deeper ones about the goals of medicine and the nature of healing in a set of engaging and candid essays the soul of medicine explores the role and influence of spirituality in clinical practice professionalism and medical education the contributors to this volume approach this topic from their own spiritual perspectives jewish christian muslim buddhist hindu new age eclectic secular jehovah s witnesses and christian scientist their thought provoking essays provide rich insights not only into the needs of patients with various world views but also into how spirituality influences the practice of medicine when their own spiritual issues arise in medical practice physicians rely on their professionalism ethics and education to better understand how various world views are incorporated into clinical work doctors must ask themselves as these contributors have a series of important questions what insights about life and healing does your faith provide how does your faith challenge or reinforce contemporary medicine how do you assess and address spirituality in clinical practice how do your own beliefs influence your interactions with patients the soul of medicine encourages medical students and practitioners to recognize the spiritual dimensions of medicine to consider how these dimensions inform their own education and practice and to be compassionate about their patients and their own religious beliefs

the problem explored in the soul of beauty is the split in modern consciousness between the world of perception and appearance on the one hand and the world of action and meaning on the other we see in one way and find truth in another the work presents this dualism as a problem in the modern sense of beauty the intent of the book is the recovery of beauty as that which brings together such contemporary splits as perception and action appearance and meaning matter and spirit subject and object beauty is imaged in two paradigms the first presents beauty as a matter of appearance which holds meaning beauty as truth the second holds that beauty is subjective experience which in its modern sense is divorced from knowledge and practical action beauty as relative experience the paradigms are formed through an imaginative and historical exploration of the tradition of beauty in western consciousness the prototype of the first paradigm beauty as appearance is seen in the goddess aphrodite who reflects the greek

sense of divinity in form itself this paradigm is then founded upon the tradition of plato in the phaedrus and the symposium plotinus dionysius and ficino the major elements of this paradigm are depicted in beauty as 1 source in a hierarchical universe 2 universal mediator 3 object of love 4 human perception 5 human knowledge 6 light and 7 unity goodness and being the suggestion is made that the paradigm of beauty as appearance is relevant for psychology as a study of soul because it brings together perception and meaning the paradigm of beauty as a subjective experience focuses historically upon beauty as a spiritual conceptual proportion methodological linear perspective and subjective phenomenon in the tradition of proportion and subjectivism knowledge is gained through perception that occurs via an organizing system such as mathematics or a concept such as proportion rather than through the direct perception of appearance meaning is separated from perception and the organizing system or concept not appearance becomes the ground of knowledge it is suggested that this paradigm reflected in scientific and conceptual psychology is problematic for psychology as a study of soul instead psychology conducts its endeavors in the service of identification with the divine control over the physical world and certainty of consciousness the final portion of the work examines the recovery of beauty as appearance in contemporary psychology through the notion of image in jung s later thought and the phenomenon of psychotherapy the work concludes with a presentation of psychology as an aesthetic enterprise bringing together meaning and appearance spirit and matter art and science subject and object

recent research in the philosophy of religion anthropology and philosophy of mind has prompted the need for a more integrated comprehensive and systematic theology of human nature this project constructively develops a theological accounting of human persons by drawing from a cartesian as a term of art model of anthropology which is motivated by a long tradition as was common among patristics medievals and reformed scholastics farris draws from philosophical resources to articulate christian doctrine as he approaches theological anthropology exploring a substance dualism model the author highlights relevant theological texts and passages of scripture arguing that this model accounts for doctrinal essentials concerning theological anthropology while farris is not explicitly interested in thorough critique of materialist ontology he notes some of the significant problems associated with it rather the present project is an attempt to revitalize the resources found in cartesianism by responding to some common worries associated with it

though some might dispute it freud along with marx darwin and einstein ranks among the intellectual fathers of the 20th century we all talk about the meaning of our dreams make freudian slips appreciate the power of unconscious desires and accept the influence of childhood experiences on adult behavior nevertheless despite his pervasive influence and all the words that have been written about him the real importance of freud s work has been obscured he asks what may be the most pressing question of the age that we live in how can we win power in our own soul as we move through the first years of a new millennium it sometimes appears that the world has become too large too complex and more dangerous and inhospitable every day we seem beset by nightmares fascism communism tribalism nationalism racism and the other isms that have prevented us as individuals and as societies from thinking clearly and acting with humanity we paid dearly for our nightmares in the 20th century and the end is not in sight we feel increasingly challenged to preserve or gain a minimum sense of community security and well being in the midst of the globalized struggle of billions of others to do the same in this struggle our political systems the governments that oversee our domestic and foreign affairs and the organizations that connect us internationally often seem overwhelmed by the effort to stave off ever threatening crises and disasters of one kind or the other no place no one no system appears immune to difficulty at a time when the major ideological and systemic competitors to western liberal democracy and free market capitalism have collapsed neither democracy nor the market appear to offer by themselves the answers we need to our many problems freud offers a way to understand ourselves that makes clear the need for a revolution within the soul if we are to rid ourselves of the nightmares and gain the capacity to live our lives with reason and humanity his focus on helping the individual banish the irrational has roots deep in western civilization in the classic greek concern with living the good life freud approaches this ultimately practical question from the perspective of one who wishes to help the individual achieve psychic health freud does not define health as happy or well adjusted nor is it contingent on physical well being health is the capacity to determine consciously and rationally one s own approach to life our relationship to the external world around us and to the internal wellsprings of our individual mental and emotional existence psychic health is a prerequisite to living the good life to using what we have at hand to the best of our ability to complete our existence as human beings plato and freud statesmen of the soul seeks to show how freud s work recalls socrates invitation in the republic to establish within ourselves the rule of reason without which we cannot live well and achieve just and well ordered societies plato showed socrates engaging individuals in dialogue one by one in order to help them understand the need to reorder their souls and subject the disorder within to the control of intellect and reason plato s socratic dialogues offer a powerful model of political change through changing individuals soul by soul for plato the nature of the soul was intrinsically a

political matter he sought to put political power into the hands of intellect and thereby into the hands of those individuals whose souls are justly ordered by intellect those thus ordered would be philosophers which in greek meant simply lovers of wisdom through the ability of these philosophers to perceive the good and consequently to act rightly the state too would be guided by the good plato and freud statesmen of the soul seeks to escape the previous mistranslations and misunderstan

in this book stephanie j shaw brings a new understanding to one of the great documents of american and black history while most scholarly discussions of the souls of black folk focus on the veils the color line double consciousness or booker t washington shaw reads du bois book as a profoundly nuanced interpretation of the souls of black americans at the turn of the twentieth century demonstrating the importance of the work as a sociohistorical study of black life in america through the turn of the twentieth century and offering new ways of thinking about many of the topics introduced in souls shaw charts du bois successful appropriation of hegelian idealism in order to add america the nineteenth century and black people to the historical narrative in hegel s philosophy of history shaw adopts du bois point of view to delve into the social cultural political and intellectual milieus that helped to create the souls of black folk

it is widely assumed that science is the enemy of religious faith the idea is so pervasive that entire industries of religious apologetics converge around the challenge of darwin evolution and the secular worldview this book challenges such assumptions by

proposing a different cause of unbelief in the west the christian conscience tracing a history of doubt and unbelief from the reformation to the age of darwin and karl marx dominic erdozain argues that the most powerful solvents of religious orthodoxy have been concepts of moral equity and personal freedom generated by christianity itself revealing links between the radical reformation and early modern philosophers such as baruch spinoza and pierre bayle erdozain demonstrates that the dynamism of the enlightenment including the very concept of natural reason espoused by philosophers such as voltaire was rooted in christian ethics and spirituality the final chapters explore similar themes in the era of darwin and marx showing how moral revolt preceded and transcended the challenges of evolution and scientific materialism in the unseating of religious belief the picture that emerges is not of a secular challenge to religious faith but a series of theological insurrections against divisive accounts of christian orthodoxy
