expression of opposition to jewish emancipation and to the growing role of jews in society the azj tended to depict the pogroms both in russia and germany as planned and organized from above rather than as spontaneous popular outbreaks the conservative non jewish papers while deploring collective violence discussed the extermination of the jews as a possible option for the solution of the jewish question thus they prepared the transformation of the seemingly civilized pre 1918 antisemitism into the post 1918 antisemitism that included violence both in word and deed
