what do we mean by gender and how does this relate to health how is biology best understood what does a focus on the division of labour bring to our understanding of health work is gender equity in health possible how have developments such as the resurgence of emotions and the new genetics affected these and other social relations at the turn of the century these are just some of the questions addressed in gender health and healing in which a whole range of issues are brought together and connected to emerging concerns in contemporary life such as the new genetics and transformations in biomedical knowledge and practices it offers a challenging assessment of gender relations and embodied practices across the public private divide using health and healing as paradigmatic examples this thought provoking volume lies at the intersection of gender studies the sociology of health and healing health policy the critical analysis of scientific knowledge and the current debates around the body health and emotions bringing together new and leading scholars in the field it provides a unique critical overview of contemporary debates in health care for an interdisciplinary readership

during the tang dynasty 618 907 changes in political policies the religious landscape and gender relations opened the possibility for daoist women to play an unprecedented role in religious and public life women from imperial princesses to the daughters of commoner families could be ordained as daoist priestesses and become religious leaders teachers and practitioners in their own right some achieved remarkable accomplishments one wrote and transmitted texts on meditation and inner cultivation another a physician authored a treatise on therapeutic methods medical theory and longevity techniques priestess poets composed major works and talented priestess artists produced stunning calligraphy in gender power and talent jinhua jia draws on a wealth of previously untapped sources to explain how daoist priestesses distinguished themselves as a distinct gendered religious and social group she describes the life journey of priestesses from palace women to abbesses and ordinary practitioners touching on their varied reasons for entering the daoist orders the role of social and religious institutions forms of spiritual experience and the relationships between gendered identities and cultural representations jia takes the reader inside convents and cloisters demonstrating how they functioned both as a female space for self determination and as a public platform for both religious and social spheres the first comprehensive study of the lives and roles of daoist priestesses in tang china gender power and talent restores women to the landscape of chinese religion and literature and proposes new methodologies for the growing field of gender and religion

environmental history has traditionally told the story of man and nature scholars have too frequently overlooked the ways in which their predominantly male subjects have themselves been shaped by gender seeing nature through gender here reintroduces gender as a meaningful category of analysis for environmental history showing how women's actions desires and choices have shaped the world and seeing men as gendered actors as well in thirteen essays that show how gendered ideas have shaped the ways in which people have represented experienced and consumed their world virginia scharff and her coauthors explore interactions between gender and environment in history ranging from colonial borderlands to transnational boundaries from mountaintop to marketplace they focus on historical representations of humans and nature on questions about consumption on environmental politics and on the complex reciprocal relations among human bodies and changing landscapes they also challenge the ecofeminist position by challenging the notion that men and women are essentially different creatures with biologically different destinies each article shows how a person or group of people in history have understood nature in gendered terms and acted accordingly often with dire consequences for other people and organisms here are considerations of the ways we study sexuality among birds of william byrd's masking sexual encounters in his account of an eighteenth century expedition of how the ecology of fire in a changing built environment has reshaped firefighters own gendered identities some are playful as in a piece on the evolution of snow bunnies to shred betties others are dead serious as in a chilling portrait of how endocrine disrupters are reinventing humans animals and water systems from the cellular level out aiding and adding significantly to the enterprise of environmental history seeing nature through gender bridges gender history and environmental history in unexpected ways to show us how the natural world can remake the gendered patterns we've engraved on ourselves and on the planet
