naturalism maintains that everything can be reduced to physical processes or are there too many recalcitrant phenomena that defy reduction can the epistemological conditions for metaphysical knowledge be met if the underdetermination of theory allows for multiple metaphysical theories to cover the same phenomena with each offering an epistemically adequate explanation then neither naturalism nor theism can be asserted to be objectively true nevertheless it is possible to favor one over the other based on overall coherence and explanatory power
