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the north american great plains and rocky mountains have yielded many artifacts and other clues about the prehistoric people who once lived there but little is understood about the hunting practices that ensured their survival for thousands of years noted archaeologist george frison brings a lifetime of experience as a hunter rancher and guide to bear on excavation data from the region relating to hunting illuminating prehistoric hunting practices in entirely new ways sharing his intimate knowledge of animal habitats and behavior and his familiarity with hunting strategies and techniques frison argues that this kind of firsthand knowledge is crucial for understanding hunting in the past

the plains indian of the upper missouri in the nineteenth century buffalo days remains the widely recognized symbol of primitive man par excellence and the persistent image of the north american indian at his most romantic fifteen cultural highlights each a chapter made from research for a particular subject and enriched by contemporary illustrations provide a sensitive interpretation of tribes such as the blackfeet the crows and the mandans from the decades before lewis and clark up to the present in an attempt to understand and record the old culture of the indians the author has developed over the past 30 years a special ethnohistorical approach the results as seen here are enlightening both for other ethnohistorians and for historians of more or less conventional bent this book is abundantly illustrated from historical sources

one of a series of more than 20 volumes resulting from the world archaeological congress september 1986 which brought together archaeologists and anthropologists from many parts of the world academics from contingent disciplines and non academics from a wide range of cultural backgrounds this book considers prehistoric and more recent manifestations of human hunting behaviour with a general emphasis on communal hunting it demonstrates that the combination of archaeological ethnographic and ethnohistorical approaches provides a researched basis for consideration of the topic on worldwide regional and local scales it includes theoretical and methodological issues within a context of enquiry original data presentation and discussion it is of interest to archaeologists anthropologists and ethnohistorians

the first book in twenty years to gather together a comprehensive prehistoric record

once the world's prairies grasslands steppes and tundra teemed with massive herds of game gazelle wild ass bison caribou and antelope humans seeking to hunt these large fast moving herds devised a range of specialised traps that share many characteristics across all continents typically consisting of guiding walls or lines of stones leading to an enclosure or trap game drives were designed for a mass killing construction of the game drive organisation of the hunt and processing of the carcass often required group co operation and in many cases game drives have been linked to seasonal gatherings of otherwise scattered groups who may have used these occasions not only to hunt but also for social ritual and economic activities the gazelle's dream game drives of the old and new worlds is the first comparative study of game drives examining this mode of hunting across three continents and a broad range of periods the book describes the hunting of bison in north america reindeer in scandinavia antelope in tibet and an extensive array of examples from the greater middle east from egypt to armenia the gazelle's dream will be of value to anyone with an interest in the history of hunting and wildlife management

specialists in the natural and social sciences the humanities and fine arts examine the involvement of the buffalo in plains ecology and culture from its prehistoric evolution and migration to its present and uncertain future

an analysis and description of archaeological materials from two early middle period sites gowen 1 and gowen 2 located in south central saskatchewan descriptions of the physical and biotic environments both past and present are provided as are detailed descriptions of various artifact assemblages and cultural features comparisons with 113 other archaeological sites situated throughout the plains area are made and a discriminant function analysis of a series of early middle prehistoric period projectile points is carried out published in english

excavation at the stampede camp and the saamis site located in medicine hat alberta resulted in the isolation of five site areas from which an abundance of artifacts were recovered providing data for detailed typological analysis cultural reconstruction and comparative studies together the two sites were occupied during the middle prehistoric late prehistoric and protohistoric periods published in english

the archaeology of large scale manipulation of prey explores the social and functional aspects of large scale hunting adaptations in the archaeological record

mass kill hunting strategies are ubiquitous in human prehistory and exhibit culturally specific economic social environmental and demographic markers here seven case studies primarily from the americas and spanning from the folsom period on the great plains to the ethnographic present in australia expand the understanding of large scale hunting methods beyond the customary role of subsistence and survival to include the social and political realms within which large scale hunting adaptations evolved addressing a diverse assortment of archaeological issues relating to the archaeological signatures and interpretation of mass kill sites the archaeology of large scale manipulation of prey reevaluates and rephrases the deep time development of hunting and the themes of subsistence to provide a foundation for the future study of hunting adaptations around the globe authors illustrate various perspectives and avenues of investigation making this an important contribution to the field of zooarchaeology and the study of hunter gatherer societies throughout history the book will appeal to archaeologists ethnologists and ecologists alike contributors jane balme jonathan driver adam c graves david maxwell ulla odgaard john d speth maría nieves zedeño

ever since the discovery of fossil remains of extinct animals associated with flint implements bones and other animal remains have been providing invaluable information to the archaeologist in the last 20 years many archaeologists and zoologists have taken to studying such archaeofaunal remains and the science of zoo archaeology has come into being what was the nature of the environment in which our ancestors lived in which season were sites occupied when did our earliest ancestors start to hunt big game and how efficient were they as hunters were early humans responsible for the extinction of so many species of large mammals 10 20 000 years ago when where and why were certain animals first domesticated when did milking and horse riding begin did the romans influence our eating habits what were sanitary conditions like in medieval england and could the terrible pestilence which afflicted the english in the seventh century ad have been plague these are some of the questions dealt with in this book the book also describes the nature and development of bones and teeth and some of the methods used in zoo archaeology

the greater plains tells a new story of a region stretching from the state of texas to the province of alberta where the environments are as varied as the myriad ways people have inhabited them these innovative essays document a complicated history of human interactions with a sometimes plentiful and sometimes foreboding landscape from the native americans who first shaped the prairies with fire to twentieth century oil regimes whose pipelines linked the region to the world the

greater plains moves beyond the narrative of ecological desperation that too often defines the region in scholarly works and in popular imagination using the lenses of grasses animals water and energy the contributors reveal tales of human adaptation through technologies ranging from the travois to bookkeeping systems and hybrid wheat transnational in its focus and interdisciplinary in its scholarship the greater plains brings together leading historians geographers anthropologists and archaeologists to chronicle a past rich with paradoxical successes and failures conflicts and cooperation but also continual adaptation to the challenging and ever shifting environmental conditions of the north american heartland

the marias river canyon in north central montana served during late holocene time as a locus of human activity in an ecologically and geologically dynamic landscape this volume presents the results of interdisciplinary research synergistically combining geologic ecologic and archaeologic approaches focused on examining the ways that late precontact peoples depended upon the animal bison and plant resources of a changing landscape subject to erosion and sediment transport as dominant surficial processes connections between erosion and deposition plant community distribution large mammal niches and native peoples place in the marias river canyon geoecosystem as well as the role of tributary junction alluvial fans as repositories of archaeological materials and vertebrate faunal remains are emphasized
