future cities for the first time in human history more than 50 of the world's population lives in urban regions cities are the largest most complex and most dynamic man made systems they are vibrant centers of cultural life and engines that drive the global economy contemporary cities are environmentally socially and economically unsustainable the quality of urban life is threatened by such factors as pollution rising temperatures limited resources congestion social inequalities aging of large sectors of the world population poverty informality crime and economic imbalances the overall planning of future cities is a challenge that can only be faced by interdisciplinary teams combining multitudes of backgrounds and expertise ecaade education and research in computer aided architectural design in europe ecaade covers europe middle east north africa and western asia and works in collaboration with the four other major international associations in the field acadia ascaad caadria caad futures and sigradi ecaade has collaborated with these associations to devise an exciting international journal for the field called the international journal of architectural computing or short ijac

global cities all over the world are taking on new roles as they increasingly participate directly and independently in international affairs and global politics so far surprisingly few studies have analyzed the role of the global city beyond its already well explicated role in the globalized economy how is it that local governments of global cities claim international political authority and develop what appears to be their own independent foreign and security policies despite the fact that such policy areas have traditionally been considered to be the core function of nation states and central governments what does it mean to be and to govern the contemporary global city in this book kristin ljunqvist claims that we can better understand why local governments find it to be in their global city's interest to claim international political authority by exploring how the city's role in the globalized world is constructed and narrated locally a core claim is that global city hood as a specific type of collective identity can play a constitutive part in such interest formation combining insights from international relations and urban studies scholarship and with the help of a case study on new york city ljunqvist develops a new analytical framework for studying the global city as an international political actor the

global city 2.0 shows that even as the global city engages in various global issues such as global environmental governance or counterterrorism such pursuit will be framed and rationalized in terms of the city's economic growth the quest for growth and global competitiveness are not necessarily the only available meanings attached to the being and governing of the contemporary global city however there seems to be a remarkable persistency and attraction in economistic ideas and an economistic conception of the global city

topless bars casino gambling needle exchange programs for drug addicts there's no question morality issues remain front and center in urban politics presenting a systematic analysis of culture war issues at the local level Elaine Sharp shows how American cities deal with these ongoing concerns drawing on a sample of ten strategically chosen cities she explains differences in how municipalities respond to controversies surrounding sex business abortion clinics legalized gambling gay rights and drug use by analyzing the relative importance of subculture economics and institutional arrangements in the disputes she points the way toward richer and more complete understanding of how different cities respond differently to these hot button issues far more than a statistical study morality politics in American cities is a collection of fascinating stories of real people grappling with down to earth issues and real life drama richly informative case studies that will captivate students and interested citizens alike mayors public health directors activists and others speak their minds about the pros and cons of these controversies here are officials in one city confronting the Vatican over funding for abortion services those in another battling a local university over its refusal to provide health benefits to gay partners of faculty members and still others mounting a massive community sponsored attack on topless clubs these stories provide detailed evidence to support classifications needed for comparing cities experience with each of the five morality issues they also corroborate inferences drawn from the comparisons by showing what considerations were in play as local officials grappled with these issues overall the study shows that cultural factors usually dominate policymaking in local politics except when specific economic interests are at stake and also observes that county level governments are more important than previously thought in terms of morality issue decisions as provocative as it is informative morality politics in American cities demonstrates that such issues same sex marriage for example are multidimensional and often difficult to resolve its conclusions however contingent mark an important step in the ongoing process of understanding important differences in

approaches to these issues and clearly show how moral conflicts continue to define american politics
