destroy god's forces are demons for real he asks yes he answers and they are very active with personal experience setting free hundreds of people from hundreds of demons who left without a fight kraft presents his approach through inner healing this he hopes will help readers who have been afraid to deal with demons to go confidently into battle with them in the authority we have in Jesus to set captives free

the demonic in the political thought of Eusebius of Caesarea explores how Eusebius of Caesarea's ideas about demons interacted with and helped to shape his thought on other topics particularly political topics Hazel Johannessen builds on and complements recent work on early Christian and early modern demonology Eusebius political thought has long drawn the attention of scholars who have identified in some of his works the foundations of later Byzantine theories of kingship however Eusebius political thought has not previously been examined in the light of his views on demons moreover despite frequent references to demons throughout many of Eusebius works there has been no comprehensive study of Eusebius views on demons until now as expressed throughout a range of his works the originality of this study lies both in an initial examination of Eusebius views on demons and their place in his cosmology and in the application of the insights derived from this to consideration of his political thought as a result of this new perspective Johannessen challenges scholars traditional characterization of Eusebius as a triumphal optimist instead she draws attention to his concerns about a continuing demonic threat capable of disrupting humankind's salvation and presents Eusebius as a more cautious figure than the one familiar to late antique scholarship

Russian tales of demonic possession translations of Savva Grudtsyn and Solomonia is a translation from the Russian of two stories of demonic possession of innocence lost and regained the original versions of both tales date back to the seventeenth century but the feats of suffering and triumph described in them are timeless Aleksei Remizov one of Russia's premiere modernists recognized the relevance of the late medieval material for his own mid twentieth century readers and rewrote both tales publishing them in 1951 under the title *The Demoniacs* the volume offers a new translation of the original tale of Savva Grudtsyn as well as first ever translations of the tale of the demoniac Solomonia and Remizov's *Demoniacs* Russian tales of demonic possession opens with an introduction that interprets and contextualizes both the late medieval and the twentieth century tales by providing new critical interpretations of all four tales as well as a short discussion of the history of demons in Russia this introduction makes an eerily exotic world accessible to today's English speaking audiences Savva Grudtsyn and Solomonia the protagonists of the two tales are young people poised on the threshold of adulthood when demons suddenly appear to confront and overmaster them each of them teeters on the brink of despair in a world filled with chaos and temptation the tale of Savva Grudtsyn and the tale of the demoniac Solomonia propel us forcibly into the

realm of good and evil and pose hard questions why does evil afflict us how does it manifest itself how can it be overcome aleksey remizov's modernist re-castings of the two stories offer compelling evidence that these same questions are very much with us today and are still in need of answers

demonic bodies and the dark ecologies of early christian culture analyzes how ancient christians constructed the christian body through its relations to demonic adversaries through case studies of new testament texts gnostic treatises and early christian church fathers e.g. ignatius of antioch clement of alexandria and tertullian of carthage this study demonstrates that the formation of early christian cultures was part of the shaping of broader christian ecosystems where nonhuman entities like demons played important roles in configuring christians experience of their bodies and surrounding environments

on september 20 1587 walpurga hausmännin of dillingen in southern germany was burned at the stake as a witch although she had confessed to committing a long list of maleficia deeds of harmful magic including killing forty one infants and two mothers in labor her evil career allegedly began with just one heinous act sex with a demon fornication with demons was a major theme of her trial record which detailed an almost continuous orgy of sexual excess with her diabolical paramour federlin in many diverse places even in the street by night as walter stephens demonstrates in demon lovers it was not hausmännin or other so-called witches who were obsessive about sex with demons instead a number of devout christians including trained theologians displayed an uncanny preoccupation with the topic during the centuries of the witch craze why to find out stephens conducts a detailed investigation of the first and most influential treatises on witchcraft written between 1430 and 1530 including the infamous malleus maleficarum hammer of witches far from being credulous fools or mindless misogynists early writers on witchcraft emerge in stephens's account as rational but reluctant skeptics trying desperately to resolve contradictions in christian thought on god spirits and sacraments that had bedeviled theologians for centuries proof of the physical existence of demons for instance through evidence of their intercourse with mortal witches would provide strong evidence for the reality of the supernatural the truth of the bible and the existence of god early modern witchcraft theory reflected a crisis of belief a crisis that continues to be expressed today in popular debates over angels satanic ritual child abuse and alien abduction
