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the oxford history of the united states is the most respected multi volume history of our nation in this volume one of america s most esteemed historians gordon s wood offers a brilliant account of the early american republic ranging from 1789 and the beginning of the national government to the end of the war of 1812 integrating all aspects of life from politics and law to the economy and culture empire of liberty offers a marvelous account of this pivotal era when america took its first unsteady steps as a new and rapidly expanding nation

this brief text covers the political social and cultural history of the united states from 1789 1829 while many books approach the period of the early republic from two distinct standpoints either from a social and cultural perspective or from a political point of view this book synthesizes all aspects of u s history during this era the early american republic 1789 1829 centers on two main themes the politics and the process of nation making from the origins of government under the constitution through the inauguration of andrew jackson and the beginnings of american market society discussing the politics of american nationhood democracy and capitalism it also examines such topics as family life religion the construction and reconstruction of gender systems the rise of popular print and other forms of communication and evolving attitudes toward slavery and race

relatively little attention has been paid to american military history between 1783 and 1812 arguably the most formative years of the united states this encyclopedia fills the void in existing literature and provides greater understanding of how the nation evolved during this era this encyclopedia offers a comprehensive examination of u s military history from the beginning of the republic in 1783 up to the eve of war with great britain in 1812 it enables a detailed study of the early republic during which ideological and political divisions occurred over the fledgling u s military the entries cover all the important battles key individuals weapons indian nations and treaties as well as numerous social political cultural and economic developments during this period the contents of the work will enable readers at the high school college university and even graduate level to comprehend how political parties emerged and how ideological differences over the organization

size and use of the military developed larger global developments including anglo american and franco american interactions relations between middle eastern states and the united states and relations and warfare between the u s government and various indian nations are also detailed the extensive and detailed bibliographies will be immensely helpful to learners at all levels

in the era of the early republic americans determined the meaning of their revolution and laid the foundation for the united states later emergence as a world power this book provides students with an explanation of the major events and developments of one of the most important periods in american history focusing on the years between the revolution and the civil war from confederation to nation presents a narrative of the era s political history along with discussions of the significant social and cultural changes that occurred across the union s first six decades taking a broad approach which examines economic changes religious influences political reform cultural challenges and racial and gender inequalities in the early republic atkins text is useful for a vast array of critical perspectives from confederation to nation presents an accessible introduction to the early american republic that offers readers a solid foundation for more advanced study

the drafting and ratification of the federal constitution between 1787 and 1788 capped almost 30 years of revolutionary turmoil and warfare the supporters of the new constitution known at the time as federalists looked to the new national government to secure the achievements of the revolution but they shared the same doubts that the anti federalists had voiced about whether the republican form of government could be made to work on a continental scale nor was it a foregone conclusion that the new government would succeed in overcoming parochial interests to weld the separate states into a single nation during the next four decades the institutions and precedents governing the behavior of the national government took shape many of which are still operative today this second edition of historical dictionary of the early american republic contains a chronology an introduction appendixes and an extensive bibliography the dictionary section has over 500 cross referenced entries on important personalities politics economy foreign relations religion and culture this book is an excellent resource for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about american history

reginald horsman s powerful and comprehensive survey of the early years of the american republic covers the dramatic years from the setting up of the us constitution in 1789 the first us presidency under george washington and also the presidencies of adams jefferson and madison a major strength of the book is that the coverage of the traditional topics about the shaping of the new government and crisis in foreign policy is combined with chapters on race slavery the economy and westward expansion revealing both the strengths and weaknesses of the government and society that came into being after the revolution key features include

in the transatlantic world of the late eighteenth century easterly winds blew radical thought to america thomas paine had already arrived on these shores in 1774 and made his mark as a radical pamphleteer during the revolution in his wake followed more than 200 other radical exiles english dissenters whigs and painites scottish lads o parts and irish patriots who became influential newspaper writers and editors and helped change the nature of political discourse in a young nation michael durey has written the first full scale analysis of these radicals evaluating the long term influence their ideas have had on american political thought transatlantic radicals uncovers the roots of their radicalism in the old world and tells the story of how these men came to be exiled how they emigrated and how they participated in the politics of their adopted country nearly all of these radicals looked to paine as their spiritual leader and to thomas jefferson as their political champion they held egalitarian anti federalist values and promoted an extreme form of participatory democracy that found a niche in the radical wing of jefferson s

republican party their divided views on slavery however reveal that democratic republicanism was unable to cope with the realities of that institution as political activists during the 1790s they proved crucial to jefferson s 1800 presidential victory then after his views moderated and their influence waned many repatriated others drifted into anonymity and a few managed to find success in the new world although many of these men are known to us through other histories their influence as a group has never before been so closely examined durey persuasively demonstrates that the intellectual ferment in britain did indeed have tremendous influence on american politics his account of that influence sheds considerable light on transatlantic political history and differences in religious political and economic freedoms skillfully balancing a large cast of characters transatlantic radicals depicts the diversity of their experiences and shows how crucial these reluctant émigrés were to shaping our republic in its formative years

james blair d 1748 moved from scotland to england and immigrated to henrico county virginia later moving to jamestown and then to williamsburg virginia where he founded william and mary college john banister d 1787 was the son of john banister the famous english botanist who had immigrated to virginia john d 1787 served with the colonists during the revolutionary war married twice and died in dinwiddie county virginia george braxton fl 1720 immigrated from england to king william county virginia one of his sons carter braxton signed the declaration of independence descendants and relatives of these three immigrants lived in virginia kentucky north carolina pennsylvania maryland delaware michigan minnesota california and elsewhere includes some ancestors and descendants in scotland england and elsewhere

as the father of the constitution james madison s accomplishments are inseparable from the nation he helped create from his early days in the state legislature of colonial virginia to his two terms as president madison worked tirelessly alongside and sometimes in opposition to his political contemporaries to secure the future of a fledgling united states in this biography author jack n rakove examines both the life and legacy of this founding father showing how the ideological foundation he helped build still supports our nation today

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
