half a dozen contributions were submitted which is remarkable in view of the intense interest of the public in the health effects of environmental degradation ranging from noise level to ozone concentration another specially designed field was the political economy of health dealing with the behavior of policy makers when deciding about changes in the health care systems it did not attract as many contributions as we had hoped for or expected
