postmodernity is a style of thought which is suspicious of classical notions of truth reason identity and objectivity of the idea of universal progress or emancipation of single frameworks grand narratives or ultimate grounds of explanation vii postmodernism then reflects these notions in what eagleton calls a depthless decentred ungrounded self reflexive playful derivative eclectic pluralistic art which blurs the boundaries between high and popular culture as well as between art and everyday experience vii although his definition is not in favor of postmodernism it does indicate how diverse subject matter as well as style in postmodern texts can be in other words anything goes mayer 543
