dionysius mentions but they intended to construct the history of christ and the added aeterni and mysterium fidei come from the tradition of the lord made known to the church by the apostles as i have received of the lord that which also i delivered unto you 1 cor xi 23 and holding the mystery of faith 1 tim iii 9 observe that st thomas also here sanctions the commentary application of st paul s words to the holy eucharist barradas does not seem to agree with the explanation of st thomas which is not precisely his own as we have seen above but scotus takes the saint s view and supports it with the same arguments as those of st thomas
