including sermons an autobiography commentaries books on prayer devotionals magazines poetry hymns and more many sermons were transcribed as he spoke and were translated into many languages during his lifetime spurgeon produced powerful sermons of penetrating thought and precise exposition his oratory skills held his listeners spellbound in the metropolitan tabernacle and many christians have discovered spurgeon s messages to be among the best in christian literature
