revolution in the making it manifests a rebellion against the two thousand year old foundations of speculation and dares to shatter the orthodoxy by venturing into the forbidden realm of a science philosophers long denied as relevant and converging the scientific method with peerless reasoning the sort that would stupefy the most weathered thinkers this most eminent opus heralds philosophy's renaissance no longer as a quaint forgotten relic of bygone eras but as a vanguard discipline poised for reawakening
