the true story of fala was written by margaret daisy suckley for her close friend and distant cousin franklin delano roosevelt celebrating the loveable scotty dog she gave the president the dog that became fdr s constant companion at the white house at press conferences during meetings with ambassadors and heads of state at home in hyde park new york on the yacht potomac and even aboard the hms prince of wales

when fdr had his first historic and highly secret meeting at sea with winston churchill during world war two fala was the most famous dog of his time and maybe the most famous dog in all of american history this classic children s book about a dog and his president has been reissued by wilderstein preservation and black dome press with a new foreword by j winthrop aldrich founding board president of wilderstein preservation and with new photographs and background information on author daisy suckley but with all the old photographs and drawings and the style and design of the original 1942 children s classic that has entertained generations
