during the 1960s and 70s some ethnomusicologists formed relationships with music makers and ritual specialists in an attempt to interpret how they understood their musical actions subsequently ethnomusicologists have studied the respects in which explicit and implicit theory is involved in communication of musical knowledge they have observed the production of music theory in institutions of modern nation states and have sought out groups and individuals whose theorizing is not constrained by existing institutions they are assessing the extent to which musical terminologies of diverse languages can be interpreted in relation to general concepts without imposing the assumptions and biases of one body of existing theory that exercise is increasingly recognized as a necessary effort of decolonization a thorough yet concise introduction to this field music theory in ethnomusicology outlines a conception of music theory suited to cross cultural research on musical practices

the result of an international event celebrating the second unesco international jazz day held on april 30 2013 at the university of padova italy this book represents the development of a project begun some years before to investigate the issue of improvisation considered as a multi faced concept and practice the initial focus of this project was to discuss the different meanings attributed to the concept of improvisation starting from questioning the common misunderstanding which interprets improvisation as a naïve behaviour rather than high level performance according with these premises education as jazz represents a metaphor and a challenge exploring the potential of jazz conceived not only as kind of music or art but rather as a mix of values attitudes and skills fundamental in everyday life and in human development as such the book adopts an interdisciplinary perspective and a multidimensional approach according to the rationale of the unesco international jazz day which highlights the role of jazz in promoting peaceful societies intercultural dialogue gender equality and innovative spirit this book offers a concrete educational resource and theoretical framework oriented towards a new pedagogy for freedom

art forms tend to mirror themselves in each other in order to understand literature and fine arts better we often turn to music speaking of the tone in a book and of the rhythm in a painting in attempts to understand music better we turn instead to the narrative arts speaking of the story of a musical piece this book focuses on two examples of such conceptual mirror reflexivity narrativity in jazz music and musicality in spoken theatre these intermedial metaphors are shown to be significant to the practice and reflection of performing artists through their ability to mediate holistic views of what is considered to be of crucial importance in artistic practice analysis and education this exploration opens up possibilities for new theoretical and practical insights with regard to how the borderland between temporal art forms can be conceptualized the book will be of interest not only to scholars of music and theatre but also to those who work in the fields of aesthetics intermedial studies cognitive linguistics arts theory communication theory and cultural studies

when he first arrived in what was then rhodesia after the nation declared independence from the united kingdom he met cosmas magaya a mbira player who would become his teacher and lifelong collaborator a prodigy s calling chronicles the early years of magaya s life documenting the master mbira player s journey from child prodigy to established expert as a child magaya was immersed in mbira music through his father s work as a healer and spirit medium as magaya grew so too did his world his performances extended beyond the family compound as his skill and knowledge increased bringing him into contact with a society fraught with decolonial conflict following magaya s childhood readers will learn how his upbringing guided his journey through the community s social networks and how his early sensibilities proclivities and talents shaped his development at the same time his deepening engagement with music and the ancestors was affected by overlapping tensions between shona cosmology and christian ideology rural and urban lifestyles and the escalating african nationalist struggle and the white supremacist state while magaya s story reflects profound social changes in the nation it is also a story of musical apprenticeship readers following magaya s discovery of ever finer details in the music s richly layered patterns will enhance their ability to hear mbira music s forms variations and sonic qualities linocut illustrations by south african artist lucas bambo bring the narrative to life and berliner s spirited storytelling is accompanied by qr codes that take readers directly to recordings of music as magaya learns it appendices for musicians interested in learning or improving their mbira playing complement the story of magaya s early life inviting the reader into the very tradition it recounts the book offers intimate insights into the relationships among music shona cosmology and colonial politics in everyday life
