diversified social environment linguists anthropologists educators and social theorists no longer believe that literacy can be defined as a concrete list of skills that people merely manipulate and use rather they argue that becoming literate is about what people do with literacy the values people place on various acts and their associated ideologies in other words literacy is more than linguistic it is political and social practice that limits or creates possibilities for who people become as literate beings such understandings of literacy have informed and continue to inform our work with teachers who take a sociological or critical perspective toward literacy instruction importantly as research indicates the disciplines pose specialized and unique literacy demands disciplinary literacy refers to the idea that we should teach the specialized ways of reading understanding and thinking used in each academic discipline such as science mathematics engineering history or literature each field has its own ways of using text to create and communicate meaning accordingly as children advance through school literacy instruction should shift from general literacy strategies to the more specific or specialized ones from each discipline teacher preparation programs emphasizing different disciplinary literacies acknowledge that old approaches to literacy are no longer sufficient literacy in teacher preparation and practice enabling individuals to negotiate meaning introduces the reader to a collection of thoughtful research based works by authors that represent current thinking about literacy across disciplines and the preparation of teachers to enter classrooms each chapter focuses on teaching guided by literacies across disciplines and the preparation of teachers who will enter classrooms to instruct the next generation of students

in october 1968 donn eisele flew with fellow astronauts walt cunningham and wally schirra into earth orbit in apollo 7 the first manned mission in the apollo program and the first manned flight after a fire during a launch pad test killed three astronauts in early 1967 apollo 7 helped restart nasa s manned spaceflight program known to many as a goofy lighthearted prankster eisele worked his way from the u s naval academy to test pilot school and then into the select ranks of america s prestigious astronaut corps he was originally on the crew of apollo 1 before being replaced due to injury after that crew died in a horrific fire eisele was on the crew selected to return americans to space despite the success of apollo 7 eisele never flew in space again as divorce and a testy crew commander led to the three astronauts being labeled as troublemakers unbeknownst to everyone after his retirement as a technical assistant for manned spaceflight at nasa s langley research center in 1972 eisele wrote in detail about his years in the air force and his time in the apollo program long after his death francis french discovered eisele s unpublished memoir and susie eisele black donn s widow allowed french access to her late husband s nasa files and personal effects readers can now experience an apollo story they assumed would never be written as well as the story behind its discovery

the american astronaut image was informed by early cold war ideals of masculinity that helped mold a distinctly american anti communist masculinity which appeared on the surface anyway to resolve not only an american crisis of masculinity but helped win the cold war on an ideological and popular level this american image focused on strict gender binaries of man as the protector controlling technology and containing communism while woman was the passive actor with spaceflight technology left behind in the home waiting for the return of the astronaut husband allowing women to fly into space would have represented a lack of individual control with spaceflight technology

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
