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our 2006 monograph tom kundig houses was an instant critical and commercial success over the past five years seattle based kundig has continued his meteoric rise collecting numerous awards including the 2008 cooper hewitt national design award for architecture design tom kundig houses 2 features seventeen residential projects ranging from a five hundred square foot cabin in the woods to a house carved into and built out of solid rock in his new work kundig continues to strike a balance between raw and refined and modern and warm creating inviting spaces with a strong sense of place the houses seamlessly incorporate his signature inventive details rich materials and stunning sites from the majestic northwestern forest to the severe high desert

architect tom kundig is known worldwide for the originality of his work this paperback edition of tom kundig houses first published in 2006 collects five of his most prominent early residential projects which remain touchstones for him today in a new preface written for this edition kundig reflects on the influence that these designs continue to have on his current thinking each house presented from conceptual sketches through meticulously realized details is the product of a sustained and active collaborative process among designer builder and client the work of the seattle based architect has been called both raw and refined disparate characteristics that produce extraordinarily inventive designs inspired by both the industrial structures ubiquitous to his upbringing in the pacific northwest and the vibrant craft cultures that are fostered there

the definitive collection of residential work by celebrated contemporary architect tom kundig tom kundig is one of the most sought after architects working today known for his extraordinary houses that deeply engage with their surrounding environment based in the pacific northwest kundig s international portfolio

includes homes built into rocky sites dynamic kinetic devices that open walls and roofs and even moving architecture that travels via railroad track spanning nearly four decades of design tom kundig complete houses presents 462 residential projects together for the first time this richly illustrated 600 page book is both a comprehensive overview of the architect s career to date and an intimate personal exploration of his creative practice the book invites readers to explore 38 of kundig s remarkable residences in depth each brought to life through original interviews with kundig portfolios of his hand drawn sketches and stunning photography beautifully designed with a striking cloth bound cover enveloped in a bespoke slipcase this monumental volume is an inspirational resource and testament to kundig s extraordinary vision as an architect

offers a selection of contemporary house designs in colour spreads from modest to massive this title features 150 of the world s most prominent architects including us architects swatt miers marmol radziner oska and lpa inc european architects jarmund vigsnaes and south american architects marcio kogan una arquitectos and fgmf

introducing architectural tectonics is an exploration of the poetics of construction tectonic theory is an integrative philosophy examining the relationships formed between design construction and space while creating or experiencing a work of architecture in this text author chad schwartz presents an introductory investigation into tectonic theory subdividing it into distinct concepts in order to make it accessible to beginning and advanced students alike the book centers on the tectonic analysis of twenty contemporary works of architecture located in eleven countries including germany italy united states chile japan bangladesh spain and australia and designed by such notable architects as tadao ando herzog de meuron kengo kuma olson kundig and peter zumthor although similarities do exist between the projects their distinctly different characteristics location and climate context size program construction methods and range of interpretations of tectonic expression provide the most significant lessons of the book helping you to understand tectonic theory written in clear accessible language these investigations examine the poetic creation of architecture showing you lessons and concepts that you can integrate into your own work whether studying in a university classroom or practicing in a professional office

a seductive stylish compelling and authoritative assembly of vanguard small scale houses that tread very lightly in nature leading the way for architects homeowners and dreamers to rethink ways we can live reside and flourish architects have sought more and more to integrate residences into their settings minimally disturbing nature with houses that float on the water or up in the trees this book reveals 51 designs that bring their residences into nature even allowing the natural setting to enter the very walls with priority given to sustainability and carbon footprint each of the book s homes is carefully chosen for its innovative and seductive design approachable scale and stunning location whether cocooned within the earth itself or soaring high amongst the treetops surrounded by cooling waters or resisting the desert heat considerations of energy consumption can dictate a green roof in some cases while blending ever more fully into the environment gives the satisfaction of not existing in contradiction with the world a kind of escape to the original garden or more precisely a return to fundamental incontrovertible values the book s collection spans the globe from a remote bay on bruny island tasmania to an isolated beach in nicaragua or cabin perched above a fjord in norway today s architectural vanguard is represented as well as established firms working at the forefront of twenty

first century design such as tom kundig of the seattle practice olson kundig and snøhetta from oslo with a wealth of photographs showcasing each house inside and out plus plans houses natural natural houses offers inspiration and tranquility

what are the challenges architects face when designing dwelling spaces of a limited size and what can these projects tell us about architecture and architectural principles in general in big little house award winning architect donna kacmar introduces twenty real life examples of small houses each project is under 1 000 square feet 100 square meters in size and brought together the designs reveal an attitude towards materiality light enclosure and accommodation which is unique to minimal dwellings while part of a trend to address growing concerns about minimising consumption and lack of affordable housing the book demonstrates that small dwellings are not always simply the result of budget constraints but constitute a deliberate design strategy in their own right highly illustrated and in full colour throughout each example is based on interviews with the original architect and accompanied by detailed floor plans this ground breaking beautifully designed text offers practical guidance to any professional architect or homeowner interested in small scale projects
