the 2001 national research council nrc report basic research opportunities in earth science broes described how basic research in the earth sciences serves five national imperatives 1 discovery use and conservation of natural resources 2 characterization and mitigation of natural hazards 3 geotechnical support of commercial and infrastructure development 4 stewardship of the environment and 5 terrestrial surveillance for global security and national defense this perspective is even more pressing today and will persist into the future with ever growing emphasis today s world with headlines dominated by issues involving fossil fuel and water resources earthquake and tsunami disasters claiming hundreds of thousands of lives and causing hundreds of billions of dollars in damages profound environmental changes associated with the evolving climate system and nuclear

atmospheric administration noaa has made significant reductions in scope to its future earth environmental observing satellites as it contends with budget shortfalls earth science and applications from space a midterm assessment of nasa s implementation of the decadal survey recommends a number of steps to better manage existing programs and to implement future programs that will be recommended by the next decadal survey the report also highlights the urgent need for the executive branch to develop and implement an overarching multiagency national strategy for earth observations from space a key recommendation of the 2007 decadal survey that remains unfulfilled
