sixty years after understanding media marshall mcluhan remains one of the best known and most influential intellectuals of the twentieth century far beyond academia readers and non readers recognize his coinages such as the gutenberg era the global village and the medium is the message a literary scholar by profession mcluhan was one of the first academics to recognize the new opportunities offered by radio and television to reach audiences beyond the readerships of scholarly journals his talks and appearances ushered in public intellectual debate concerning the electronic age although his reputation waned in the 1970s the recent making available to the public of his extraordinary personal library of some six thousand books enables new kinds of analyses of mcluhan as a reader thinker and cultural force the essays here focus not so much on his media theory per se as on the habits and practices that animated his reading and on the larger questions of what reading and not reading mean we don t need to agree with everything mcluhan says to make valuable

use of his work new resources offer us an unprecedented opportunity to revisit one fallible human reader whose texts and ideas are good to think with and against this book was originally published as a special issue of the journal *textual practice*

when the canadian government committed forces to join the military mission in afghanistan following the terrorist attacks of september 11 2001 little did it foresee that this decision would involve canada in a war riven country for over a decade the politics of war explores how as the mission became increasingly unpopular canadian politicians across the political spectrum began to use it to score points against their opponents this was politics with a vengeance through historical analysis of the public record and interviews with officials jean christophe boucher and kim richard nossal show how the canadian government sought to frame the engagement in afghanistan as a mission rather than what it was a war they examine the efforts of successive governments to convince canadians of the rightness of canada s engagement the parliamentary politics that resulted from the increasing politicization of the mission and the impact of public opinion on canada s involvement this contribution to the field of canadian foreign policy demonstrates how much of canada s war in afghanistan was shaped by the vagaries of domestic politics and political gamesmanship

unceded is a compelling history of the bc government s relationship with indigenous peoples from early land question disputes to current reconciliation efforts treaty commissioner george m abbott combines archival research with a former cabinet minister s insider perspective on government to chronicle over 150 years of bc indigenous relations he details how early government officials refused to negotiate treaties instead coercing first nations onto small reserves despite sustained indigenous resistance the situation only worsened in the decades that followed until several supreme court decisions compelled the province to sit down at the negotiating table more recently the province has taken steps toward reconciliation including passing legislation recognizing indigenous rights as abbott shows overcoming the legacy of colonialism is no small task but achieving justice is worth the effort unceded will help all british columbians understand historical wrongs and the obstacles to righting them
