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this book integrates humanist approaches in enabling both spiritual growth and social science knowledge in advocating for the emancipation of exploited women children and youth based on critical realism through an autoethnographic account of the first author s journey from being a secular jew through anglicanism to quakerism and then islam a pacifist based social science methodology is developed this approach describes attempts to understand and liberate sexually exploited youths in bangladesh exploited women and girls in pakistan and struggling women in gaza palestine the model attempts to integrate moral goals of judaism christianity and islam in seeking peaceful co operation secular humanism is added creating a research model which seeks the enhancement of human welfare through the universal ethic of the social contract in which humans and their welfare are both interesting and exciting a review of research on child sexual exploitation elaborates the model of child centred humanism

throughout the history of psychology there have been full investigations of discrete emotions particularly negative ones and a recent wealth of books on happiness but few exist on the emotion of joy this book takes a unique psychological approach to understanding this powerful emotion and provides a framework within which the study of human joy and other related positive fulfillment experiences can fit in a meaningful schema a key feature of this book is its development of an experiential phenomenology of joy this

phenomenology is based on more than three hundred descriptions of joy experiences recounted by subjects in an empirical study executed by the author types of joy experiences are examined such as excited vs serene joy anticipatory vs completed joy and affiliative vs individuated joy there is no comparable book or work that clarifies the relationship among major positive states with emotional components including satisfaction happiness and ecstasy

the ideas of max wertheimer 1880 1943 a founder of gestalt theory are discussed in almost all general books on the history of psychology and in most introductory textbooks on psychology this intellectual biography of wertheimer is the first book length treatment of a scholar whose ideas are recognized as of central importance to fields as varied as social psychology cognitive neuroscience problem solving art and visual neuroscience king and wertheimer trace the origins of gestalt thought demonstrating its continuing importance in fifteen chapters and several supplements to these chapters they begin by reviewing wertheimer s ancestry family childhood in central europe and his formal education they elaborate on his activities during the period in which he developed the ideas that were later to become central to gestalt psychology documenting the formal emergence of this school of thought and tracing its development during world war i the maturation of the gestalt school at the university of berlin during 1922 1929 is discussed in detail wertheimer s everyday life in america during his last decade is well documented based in part on his son s recollections the early reception of gestalt theory in the united states is examined with

extensive references to articles in professional journals and periodicals wertheimer s relationships and interaction with three prominent psychologists of the time edwin boring clark hull and alexander luria are discussed based on previously unpublished correspondence the final chapters discuss wertheimer s essays on democracy freedom ethics and truth and detail personal challenges wertheimer faced during his last years his major work published after his death is productive thinking its reception is examined and a concluding chapter considers recent responses to max wertheimer and gestalt theory this intellectual biography will be of interest to psychologists and readers inte
