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drawing on interviews with civil society organizations and in conjunction with an examination of eu civil society policy and the legal and institutional environment in turkey this book examines eu policies on turkish civil society organizations and highlights the significant constraints and limited impacts of these policies

this book explores the existence of gaps between public preferences and institutional designs in democracies and specifically cases in which such gaps are maintained for a long period of time without being challenged by the electorate gaps such as these can be seen in the complex relations between the state and religion in israel and turkey and more specifically in their policies on marriage this line of investigation is interesting both theoretically and empirically as despite their poles apart policies israel and turkey share a similar pattern of institutional dynamics existing explanations for this phenomenon suggested either civil society based arguments or intra institutional dynamics as reasons for the maintenance of such gaps this book enriches our understanding of policy dynamics in democratic systems by introducing a third line of argument one that emphasizes the effective role state institutions play in maintaining such arrangements for long periods often against the public will

this collection brings together legal scholars canonists and political scientists to focus on the issue of public funding in support of religious activities and institutions in europe the study begins by revolving around the various mechanisms put in place by the domestic legal systems as well as those resulting from the european law of human rights and the law of the european union it then goes on to look at state support and particular religious groups the presentation of european and national law is supplemented by theoretical and interdisciplinary contributions with the main focus being to bring into

the executive organ in terms of its change in status in relation to other centers of political power the conclusion provides an overview of the apparent oscillation of turkish public administration in the 21st century in terms of europeanization processes this book is useful for academics studying public administration public management reforms turkish politics and the european union as well as government and diplomatic professionals in turkey and the eu especially those dealing with enlargement issues

how safe is turkey s liberal democracy the rise to power in 2002 of the right leaning islamic justice and development party ignited fears in the west that turkey could no longer be relied upon to provide a buffer against the growth of islamic fundamentalism in the middle east once hailed by the west as a model of secularism and moderation in the muslim world turkey is now seen to be under the influence of the creeping islamisation of the jdp or akp as it is known in turkey yet to what extent has this affected the lives of turkish citizens evangelia axiarlis here explores the contribution of the jdp to civil liberties and basic freedoms long suppressed by secular and statist kemalist ideology and how this has remained unexamined despite more than a decade in government in this the first detailed study of the policies and ideology of prime minister recep tayyip erdo an s government the author examines the extent to which the jdp has worked to improve civil life in turkey and critically addresses whether a government built on islamic principles can champion political reform exploring how islam and democracy are neither monoliths nor mutually exclusive this is a timely contribution to the wider understanding of political islam

by critically addressing the tension between nationalism and human rights that is presumed in much of the existing literature the essays in this volume confront the question of how we should construe human rights as a normative challenge to the excesses of modernity particularly those associated with the modern nation state or as an adjunct of globalization with its attendant goal of constructing a universal civilization based on neoliberal economic principles and
