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this third compendium of the committee on divine worship s i newsletter i is a resource and research tool for liturgists scholars priests and pastoral leaders on the liturgical developments for the catholic church in the united states of america from 2011 through 2020 as historical documents the newsletters are provided as originally published the liturgical topics covered in this compendium concern the implementation of the third edition of the roman missal the year of faith historical and pastoral reflections on the fiftieth anniversary of the promulgation of *sacrosanctum concilium* the inclusion of sts john xxiii and john paul ii on the general roman calendar ritual translation updates and implementation notes pertaining to the dedication of a church and an altar exorcisms

matrimony baptism confirmation blessing of oils and the liturgy of the hours

assemblies recognize the difference between a lector who simply reads and one who truly proclaims the word of god they perk up and take special notice when they sense that the lector has worked to get inside the text to express the meaning authentically and to draw them into the story douglas leal has spent decades as a lector lector trainer actor and director he knows how to coach lectors beyond reading so they can become proclaimers of the word the conversational spirited style of the book recreates the sense of a live training session with the author in a magazine format with running text surrounded by boxes that focus on a particular subjects and techniques a tool from the actor s toolbox or an encouraging story from the world of acting the book presents a wealth of wisdom and practical instruction that can carry a lector far beyond basic training chapter by chapter leal guides lectors to understand their role as sacred storytellers learn how to study the text closely understand its style notice its literary devices consider its context in the bible the liturgical year and the lectionary use scripture resources to arrive at its meaning practice the text and pray it work with their voice articulation tempo rhythm pauses volume and inflection develop comfort with nonverbal skills eye contact posture and facial expression choose an intention appropriate to the text and responsive to the needs of the community understanding and expressing the true emotional content of the text staying focused on the text cultivating authenticity and humility and seeking feedback overcoming nervousness mistakes colds and other unexpected problems developing a plan for practice and preparation

how should christians speak of the transcendent yet personal god when our language for persons is almost always gendered is male imagery such as father son or king the only appropriate way are there ways to talk of god using female gendered metaphors and pronouns and how does the use of such language impact humans as gendered people moving beyond the extremes in this debate the father and the feminine seeks to clarify the ways christians speak about god whether this is by recognizing revelation and christian tradition upholding god s ineffability using analogies metaphors and narratives referring to god as father son and spirit or by seeking a liberating way of life in community spencer miles boersma argues that male language for god need not be problematic if used and understood correctly but at the same time that it cannot be the exclusive way christians speak of the divine the grammar of christian scripture and tradition both authorize the use of female language which christians ought to use in pursuing a deeper relationship with god and others as well as a more authentic view of self

the mass of paul vi is so deeply flawed that it cannot be repaired from within whether by copious helpings of smells and bells by arbitrary attempts at traditionalizing or by an official reform of the reform and the roman mass inherited from the age of faith did not and does not need to be reformed along antiquarian or pastoral utilitarian lines as it fulfills the highest act of religion in a fitting manner perfected over many centuries of prayerful practice the liturgical revolution driven by ideology culminated in balkanization banality and boredom its fabrications must be retired from use and the traditional rite must be restored to its rightful place of honor in the church of the latin rite such are the bold claims defended in close the workshop why the old mass isn t broken and the new mass can t be fixed in which peter kwasniewski refutes the reformers own case for reforming the old rite and illustrates the subtle dangers to which clergy and laity are exposed by attempts at doing the new rite reverently simultaneously he reminds traditionalists that they should aspire to the noblest possible celebration of the mass always faithfully observing the rubrics and resisting bad habits that interfere with the rite s full splendor and efficacy unseemly haste minimalism ineptitude and the itch for pastoral experimentation if the catholic church in the west is ever to recover her internal soundness and external cultural influence her shepherds and her flocks must let the ill advised council of the 1960s and the bauhaus liturgy cobbled together in its name lapse into obsolescence so that the perennially fresh theology of the council of trent and the immortally beautiful liturgy of the roman church may once again flourish unfettered

in how catholics encounter the bible award winning biblical scholar and historian michael peppard explores the paradoxical role of the bible for catholics a book central to their tradition but one which catholics rarely read instead as peppard shows biblical ideas influence catholics through diverse modes of storytelling artistic imagination and ritual through examples of pilgrimage visual arts poetry music and even on netflix peppard shows how the bible thrives among catholics even if its printed text may be missing
