child sexual abuse reported by adult survivors is a wide ranging and timely critical history and analysis of legal responses to historical or non recent child sexual abuse nrca in england and wales ireland and australia each of which represents an evolving and progressive approach to this important and complex issue the book examines the emergence of nrca as a distinctive social political and legal phenomenon in each country and explores the legal responses developed to address its unprecedented challenges courts and parliaments in each country have reformed existing doctrine and

practice and have created new ways of holding state and private actors accountable and new ways of addressing survivors injuries criminal law tort law public inquiries and state reparations have all been to the forefront of these new legal responses which have transformed law s engagement with nrca survivors and understandings of justice itself however despite this undeniable progress the book identifies ways in which the legal responses developed in each country fail to deliver accountability and recognition to nrca survivors and argues that such failures betray the law s inherent ambivalence to delivering justice for these survivors creating new insights into legal responses to this complex contemporary legal social and political problem this book will be of great interest to academic lawyers political scientists and historians as well as those working on related topics in criminology sociology social policy cultural studies and gender studies

women experience sexual and domestic violence at alarmingly high rates recovery from this type of trauma can be a complex and extensive process that in best cases involves a broad network for support this dissertation examined the experiences of women over the age of 21 who have received massage therapy during their healing process from sexual or domestic violence for the purposes of this study the women who participated were often referred to as survivors of abuse current research examined in the literature review indicates that the effects of this type of trauma are multifaceted and that one of the interventions sought for diminishing the effects of this trauma is massage the importance of this study completed with the use of descriptive research methodology included the opportunity to gain information from abuse survivors about their personal experiences with massage and how they can best be served by the massage therapist the results of a self report survey and interview process provide valuable information to raise awareness of these societal issues among massage professionals while the subjects were not interviewed about their specific experiences of abuse they provided important information about the effects that these experiences have had on their lives further the women interviewed shared information about the concerns that they had with regard to massage therapy and some of the specific experiences that they have had during massage sessions although the sample size was small with 10 women interviewed the information provided has clear implications for the practice of massage therapy some of the implications found involve therapist gender trust building between client and practitioner and communication with the client during massage therapy sessions recommendations for massage professionals have been made based on these findings further research opportunities exist in several areas and include screening massage clients for abuse during the intake process examining the challenges for male massage therapists and female massage therapists and evaluating the massage educational institutions for training in issues of trauma particular to sexual and

domestic violence

first published in 1995 this is volume five of a series that looks at the developmental stages in addressing the complex and social problem of child abuse the articles in this volume address the treatment of child victims and adult survivors of childhood sexual physical and emotional abuse and neglect where physical abuse is concerned treatment of victims and survivors lagged far behind the treatment of sexual abuse victims and survivors this may be due in part to the fact that in cases of physical abuse with its physical manifestations that heal more attention is paid to the immediate physical safety of children than to their short and long term emotional needs thereafter the focus of treatment tended to be on parents in hopes of preventing further abuse rather than on the abused children
