this book offers a comprehensive examination of methodist practice tracing its evolution from the earliest days up to the present using liturgical texts as well as written accounts in popular and private sources karen westerfield tucker investigates the various rites and seasons of worship in methodism and examines them in relation to american society

with the decision to provide of a scholarly edition of the works of john wesley in the 1950s methodist studies emerged as a fresh academic venture building on the foundation laid by frank baker albert outler and other pioneers of the discipline this handbook provides an overview of the best current scholarship in the field the forty two included essays are representative of the voices of a new generation of international scholars summarising and expanding on topical research and considering where their work may lead methodist studies in the future thematically ordered the handbook provides new insights into the founders history structures and theology of methodism and into ongoing developments in the practice and experience of the contemporary movement key themes explored include worship forms mission ecumenism and engagement with contemporary ethical and political debate

are there common threads or characteristics uniting the worship of churches that stand in the wesleyan tradition what theological assumptions undergird the practice of methodist worship in different cultural contexts is the liturgical heritage bequeathed by john wesley and the early methodists still honored in twentieth century methodist worship how broadly has the twentieth century liturgical movement influenced methodist worship have methodists made unique liturgical contributions in the establishment and evolution of uniting churches in australia canada or india what are the implications of twentieth century methodist worship for evangelism and missions these are some of the questions addressed in this volume which examines the theological historical cultural and practical implications of sunday morning worship as it is celebrated in churches around the world claiming methodist wesleyan roots

the history of the three year lectionaries tells a tale of an evolving hermeneutic originating in the roman lectionary this hermeneutic was developed in subsequent denominational and ecumenical versions most recently the revised common lectionary in keeping with the broad appeal of the three year lectionary pattern the hermeneutic is ecumenical in character an amalgam of the historical hermeneutics of the two western traditions it uses both the memory of the church to interpret the bible and the bible to structure the memory of the church after an examination of the hermeneutic west lays out the memory patterns of the two most widely used versions of this lectionary the roman lectionary and the revised common lectionary

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
