

Urban Regeneration In Europe

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this book provides a comparative account of the process of urban regeneration and examines the factors influencing these processes as well as the consequences of their implementation through a mixture of theoretical discussion and a series of case studies a thorough examination is made of the extent to which these different european old industrial conurbations are facing similar problems

the material in this book is based upon an academic conference held in liverpool in 1990 which explored west european urban development and strategies by looking at commissioned studies of cities in six ec countries britain the netherlands france spain germany and italy

this collection discusses the challenges of reforming eu democracy through increased citizen participation beyond elections it asks fundamental questions such as whether the institutionalisation of citizens in eu public law is a prerequisite for addressing these challenges and the extent to which such institutionalisation is taking place in the eu to these ends the contributors analyse the latest institutional initiatives proposals and practices such as citizen assemblies citizen consultations and dialogues on european integration and draft legislation the conference on the future of europe the reform of the european citizens initiative the evolving role of the european ombudsman citizen petitions to the european parliament the roles of the civil society and the european economic and social committee offering reflections on the impact of the covid 19 pandemic this book is a much needed reminder of the importance of the role of citizens in eu governance

the searches by european union major states for joined up approaches to inner city regeneration are examined thematically through a focus on policy evolution since the mid 1970s key issues addressed include the physical social employment and urban security agenda the product of long term research drawing on extensive qualitative and quantitative sources at national level backed by in depth case study investigation of five large cities the

book assesses how contemporary urban rejuvenation is being regulated including the increasing contribution of the european union

this book focuses on territorial policies as instruments for local development in europe s periphery using a multiple case research design in three typical case studies in the context of the mediterranean island of sardinia italy we empirically test the hypothesis that the institutionalisation of the governance system is an independent variable that is capable of influencing the quality of public policy intended as a dependent variable according to this hypothesis the two above mentioned variables tend to change according to a linear and direct correlation upward variation of the degree of institutionalisation of the governance system tends to correspond to upward variation in the quality of the policy and vice versa in our conclusions we discuss the descriptive and prescriptive implications of the empirical findings of the research for the local development of peripheral areas regarding the descriptive implications we explain how territorial policy making can be articulated based on the degree of institutionalisation of the governance system and the quality of the territorial policies regarding the prescriptive implications we identify the best practices for territorial governance in order to improve the chances of local development in europe s periphery

growth mass tourism and unequal access to socio economic opportunities urban heritage development and sustainability examines the impact of these issues on urban heritage considering innovative approaches to managing developmental pressures and focusing on how taking an ethical inclusive and holistic approach to urban planning and heritage conservation may create a stronger basis for the sustainable growth of cities in the future this volume is a timely analysis of current theories and practises in urban heritage with particular reference to the conflict between and potential reconciliation of conservation and development goals a global range of case studies detail a number of distinct practical approaches to heritage on international national and local scales chapters reveal the disjunctions between international frameworks and national implementation and assess how internationally agreed concepts can be misused to justify unsustainable practices or to further economic globalisation and political nationalism the exclusion of many local communities from development policies and the subsequent erosion of their cultural heritage is also discussed with the collection emphasising the importance of grass roots heritage and exploring more inclusive and culturally responsive conservation strategies contributions from an international group of authors including practitioners as well as leading academics deliver a broad and balanced coverage of this topic addressing the interests of both urban planners and heritage specialists urban heritage development and sustainability is an important addition to the field that will encourage further discourse

a history of our time

recent developments in cultural heritage policy and practice in south east europe since 2003 the council of europe european commission joint initiative known as the ljubljana process rehabilitating our common heritage has set out to unlock the potential of the region s rich immovable cultural heritage working with national authorities to accelerate the development of democratic peaceful and open societies stimulate local economies and improve the quality of life of local communities in 2003 the region was overcoming the effects of the traumatic transition to a market economy since then it has been hit hard by the economic crisis of 2008 and more recently by an unprecedented migration crisis despite the challenges facing the region in the field of cultural heritage the present situation can be seen as an opportunity to use the lessons learned from the ljubljana process to avoid the traps laid by the cumulative and sometimes inconsistent heritage protection legislation of the past 60 years overcoming the legacy of the top down approach that privileges the high art canon rather than the local heritage that reflects the culture of everyday life and which often means more to most people the authors suggest that selecting from innovative practice elsewhere could make heritage management smarter so that it more directly meets the needs of modern society and individual citizens this volume reflects the views of international experts involved in the joint

initiative and complements earlier studies on the impact of the ljubljana process by experts from within the region heritage for development in south east europe edited by gojko rikolović and hristina mikić 2014 and from the london school of economics and political science the wider benefits of investment in cultural heritage case studies in bosnia and herzegovina and serbia edited by will bartlett 2015

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
