haunting the evocation of emotional life vivid but abu lughod's analysis also reveals how deeply implicated poetry and sentiment are in the play of power and the maintenance of social hierarchy what begins as a puzzle about a single poetic genre becomes a reflection on the politics of sentiment and the complexity of culture this thirtieth anniversary edition includes a new afterword that reflects on developments both in anthropology and in the lives of this community of awlad ali bedouins who find themselves increasingly enmeshed in national political and social formations the afterword ends with a personal meditation on the meaning for all involved of the radical experience of anthropological fieldwork and the responsibilities it entails for ethnographers
