evolving moral status of consumer credit showing how it changed from a widespread but morally dubious practice into an almost universal and generally accepted practice by world war ii combining clear rigorous arguments with a colorful narrative style financing the american dream will attract a wide range of academic and general readers and change how we understand one of the most important and overlooked aspects of american social and economic life
