policies reforms and resistance divmost importantly studying how north carolina education systems and actors adapt to meet the challenges may offer valuable opportunities for researchers to understand the transformation of educational systems in other new gateway states collectively studies in this book deconstruct the framework of the traditional hierarchical assimilation and linguisticism policies in recasting the concept of becoming americans in the new south the authors utilize frameworks that recognize the structural barriers that disadvantage immigrants in new gateway states but also position youth families and communities as possessing and utilizing valuable resources to promote educational access and achievement in this sense this book contributes significantly to major contemporary empirical and theoretical debates relating to educating immigrant children it is our hope that this critical dialogue will continue at a national platform to promote discussion of these timely issues div div
