*negro soldiers who wanted to remain in the united states army after the civil war were organized into the ninth and tenth cavalry regiments their service in controlling hostile indians on the great plains during the next twenty years was as invaluable as it was unrecognized*

*realizing that his future lies in owning land not just being free a young man raised as a slave becomes a buffalo soldier a member of an all black cavalry regiment formed to protect white settlers from indians bandits and outlaws and that later fought in the spanish american war includes historical note*

*our journey with the buffalo soldiers is a compilation of historical research travel adventures family histories and personal stories african american military units were established in 1866 and these soldiers had much to prove they earned the name buffalo soldiers from indians who held their fighting spirit in high regard over the years they served in all of the military conflicts the indian wars the spanish american war world war i and world war ii stories of racial prejudice are peppered throughout their history during world war ii the army mechanized their equipment and these units were disbanded this journey focuses on the stories of world war ii soldiers but a historical perspective is provided to lay the foundation for these stories information about lt henry o flipper the first african american graduate from the west point military academy and other historical military figures are included each story is situated by its location and is part of the journey the stories about the world war ii soldiers are personal and touching some described how they were afraid of horses*

but learned to ride clean and feed them there are more stories about traveling by train across the us living on a ship going across the atlantic ocean experiencing a accident in a jeep during the european theater leaving the army and joining the air force and life events after world war ii many men returned home and took advantage of the gi bill or settled into stable government jobs photographs and interviews with buffalo soldiers who attended the reunions of the buffalo soldiers every july add a special touch city by city and fort by fort personal stories are connected to each location from thomasville ga to portland or the buffalo soldiers have many stories to share on april 8 2004 george bicks iii wrote i get excited when i read stories about african american men who served in the u s army as infantryman and cavalryman these soldiers buffalo soldiers were my ancestors i grew up in the 1950s 1960s watching westerns movies and i never saw black men riding horses nor as soldiers in the all white u s cavalry regiments not until the 1980s when the stories of black soldiers were covered in the media did i revisit my childhood and ask questions the buffalo soldiers were mistreated issued inferior clothing and equipment and received less compensation for their effort they were assigned to military posts far from their families and the townspeople because the same people that they were to protect did not like the color of their skin they endured the storms and i am so very proud of my black brothers i have visited places where they served washington dc california virginia arizona mexico washington oregon and kansas and lived in their hometowns i interviewed troopers who served in the 9th 10th 27th and 28th horse cavalry regiments the landscape where they served even today looks rough hot and uncomfortable if they could do what they did under those conditions servicing this country surely i can sit in the comforts of my home and write about what i discovered about my ancestors i decided to tell what i am learning about these men and women yes there was at least one documented female buffalo soldier cathy williams it feels good to write positive stories about us perhaps there are other positive stories that need to be written if you discover a subject that inspires you sit down and start writing for future generations it is our history when you know your past you can better understand your present and prepare for the future on june 22 2004 carmon weaver bicks wrote george led most of the journey when you read a section that starts with the pronoun i the i is george for many sections the pronoun is we we learned so much worked so hard and feel so good about our efforts this journey has been george s mission but you

the buffalo soldier played an important part in the us army s operations during the age of american imperialism between 1898 and 1916 these men campaigned against the spanish in cuba san juan hill 1898 filipino insurrectionists on mindanao and mexican border raiders they went on to distinguish themselves in the trenches of world war i 1914 1918 and the sum of two divisions of these doughboys fought with the french army and the american expeditionary force this book offers a succinct history of these units and the campaigns in which they fought and it highlights the african american us soldier his uniforms and his gear throughout this era in rare photographs and carefully reconstructed color illustrations

the african american troops known as the buffalo soldiers helped change the american west from 1867 to 1891 they fought over a hundred battles in the indian wars they risked their lives in other ways including enforcing the law guarding wagon trains exploring unknown territory and building built roads and telegraph lines they helped win the famous battle of san juan heights in cuba perhaps saving the life of future president theodore roosevelt everywhere they went the faced racism and bigotry they defended themselves but almost never over reacted to the threats against them they showed courage not only in what they did but what they didn t do for many years they were forgotten heroes no longer their history is america s history

in the middle of the arid summer of 1877 a drought year in west texas a troop of some forty buffalo soldiers african american cavalry led by white officers struck out into the llano estacado from double lakes south of modern lubbock pursuing a band of kwahada comanches who had been raiding homesteads and hunting parties a group of twenty two buffalo hunters accompanied the soldiers as guides and allies several days later three black soldiers rode into fort concho at modern san angelo and reported that the men and officers of troop a were missing and presumed dead from thirst the staked plains horror as the galveston daily news called it quickly captured national attention although most of the soldiers eventually straggled back into camp four had died and others eventually faced court martial for desertion the buffalo hunters had ridden off on their own to find water and the surviving soldiers had lived by drinking the blood of their dead horses and their own urine a routine army scout had turned into disaster of the worst kind although the failed expedition was widely reported at the time its sparse treatments since then have relied exclusively on the white officers accounts paul carlson has mined the courts martial records for testimony of the enlisted men memories of a white boy who rode with the indians and other buried sources to provide the first multifaceted narrative ever published his gripping account provides not only a fuller version of what happened over those grim eighty six hours but also a nuanced view of the interaction of soldiers hunters settlers and indians on the staked plains at this

*poignant moment before the final settling of the comanches on their reservation in indian territory*

*recounts the history of the 9th and 10th cavalry regiments comprised of african american soldiers recruited to open the west to settlers and whose deeds included escorting wagon trains carrying mail and fighting battles against native americans*

*the buffalo saga chronicles a buffalo soldier s nexus of the dynamics of race and war world war ii army s 92nd infantry division known as the buffalo soldiers was the only division strength unit made up of african americans to fight in the european theater this was an all black unit although the highest ranking officers were white the 92nd was assigned to northern italy where they fought against german and italian troops they served with great distinction from late 1944 until the end of the war with many killed and wounded these men were great heroes and great americans who waged a fight for freedom abroad even as they were denied freedom at home after the war they returned to a still segregated united states of america*

*the italians in the towns and villages liberated by the buffalo soldiers during world war ii called them giganti buoni the good giants they did not know that these giants would return to a country where they were still second class citizens in 2012 ivan j houston one of those remaining buffalo soldiers was invited to return to italy by the owner of a villa his battalion captured he and his family would be guests at the fifteenth century villa orsini now a bed and breakfast renamed the villa la dogana his return to tuscany almost seventy years after the war had ended was filled with emotion in this book he describes how he went back to a place where african american buffalo soldiers are considered heroes and liberators he visits battlefields where more than three thousand african american buffalo soldiers were killed or wounded as they battled nazi and fascist soldiers the author and his family returned to italy for five consecutive years visiting the battle sites and celebrating ancient victories that will never be forgotten*
